**Notice of Seattle City Council Public Hearing on Pike Place Market and Seattle Aquarium Memoranda of Understanding**

The Seattle City Council Central Waterfront, Seawall, and Alaskan Way Viaduct Replacement Program Committee will accept public comment on two proposed ordinances that authorize proposed Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) -- one with the Pike Place Market Public Development Authority and one with the Seattle Aquarium Society -- relating to partner projects to complement the City's renovation of the Central Waterfront. The MOUs outline guiding principles, design development principles, a process to finalize project development agreements, and provisions for City funding to support collaborative design work by these partner agencies. The MOUs include baseline concept designs for the partner agency projects that will be refined in coordination with City design of public-right-of-way improvements including the Overlook Walk, the plaza in front of the Aquarium, and new Alaskan Way and Elliott Avenue surface streets. The MOUs anticipate that the City will enter into formal project development agreements incorporating refined designs subject to City review and approval in the latter part of 2013. These MOUs were called for by Council Resolution 31399 relating to the Central Waterfront Concept Design adopted in August 2012.
