

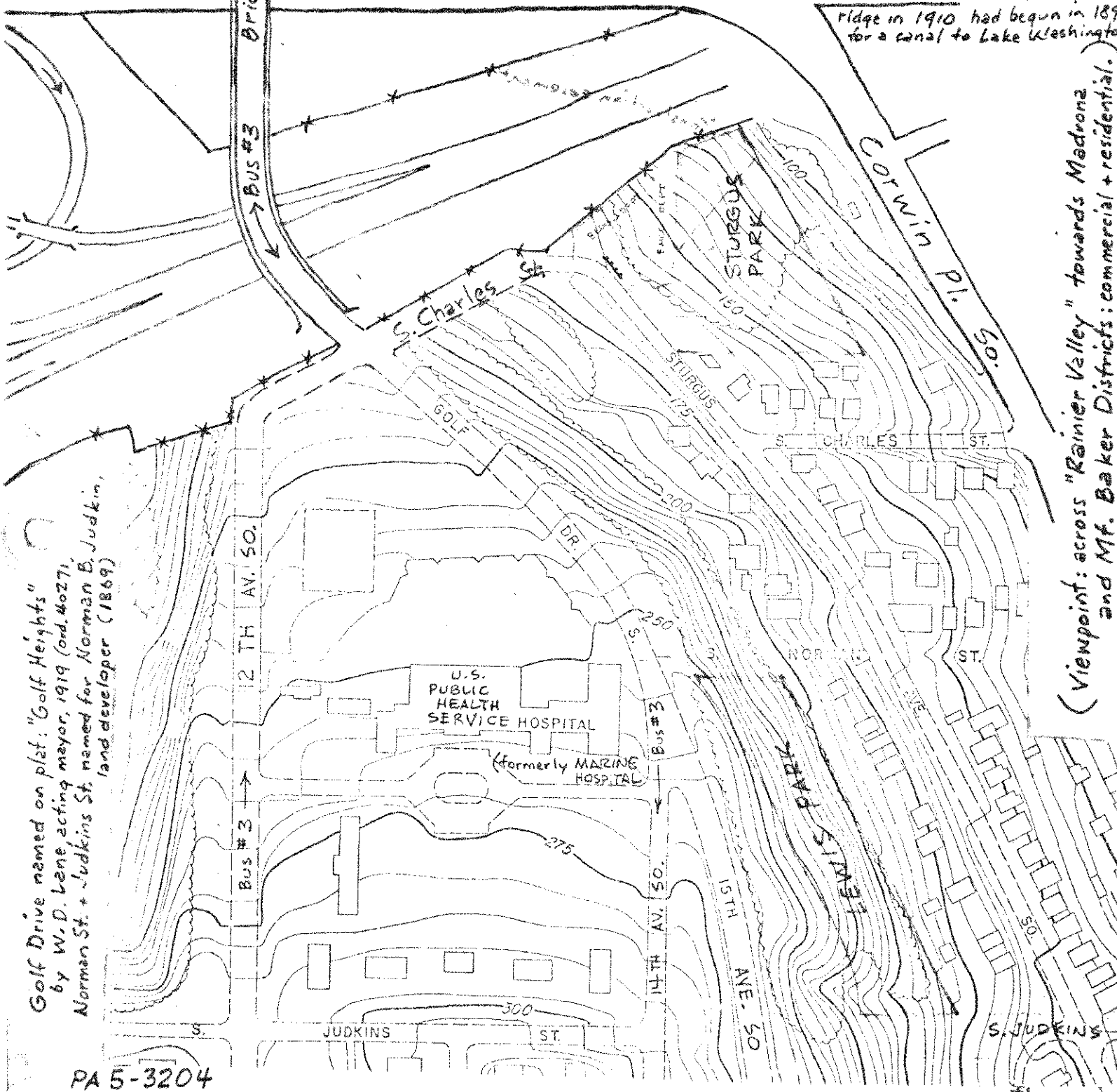
W. S. W. Weed's slope

 and Mt. Baker Districts; commercial + residential)

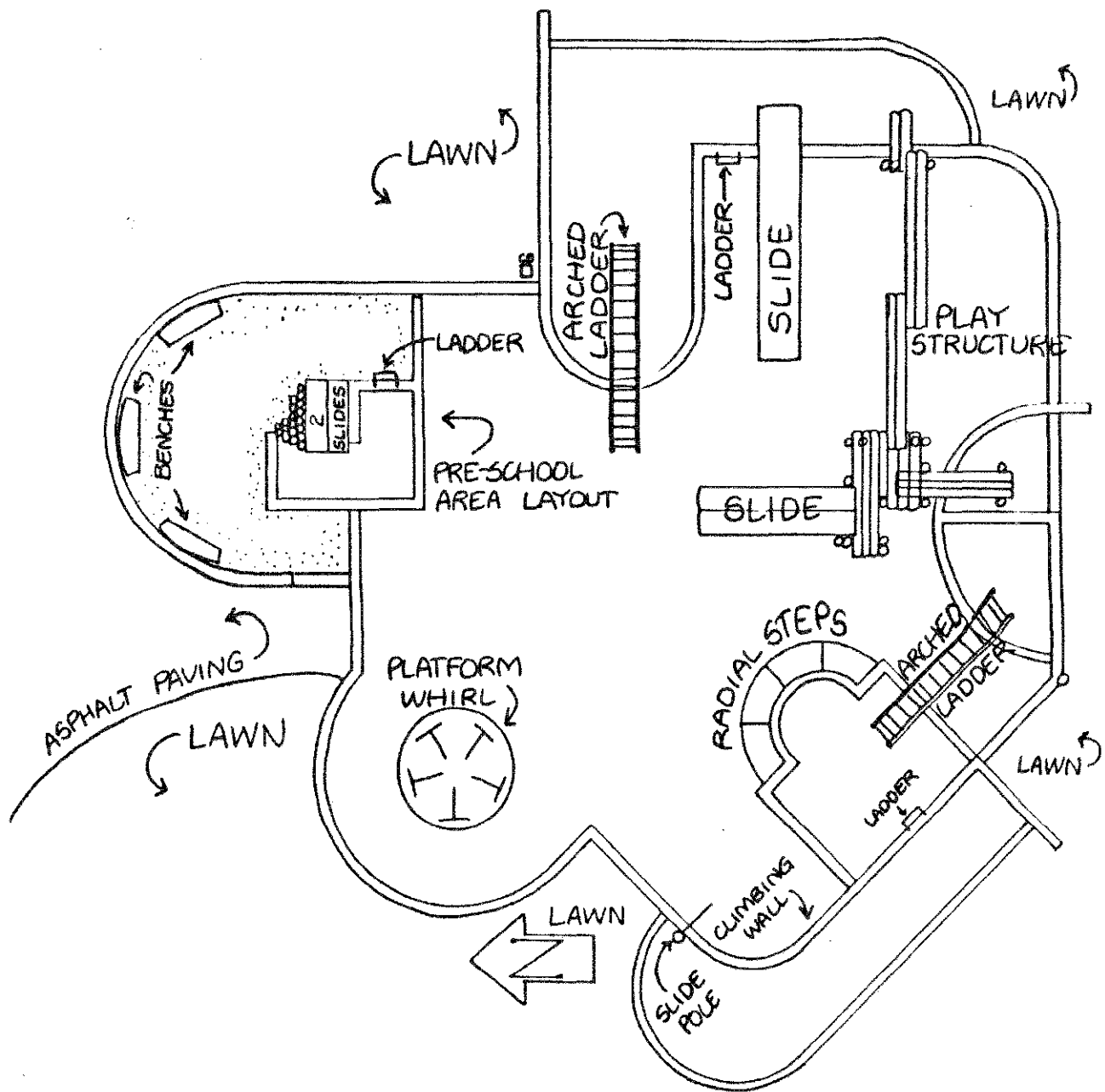
