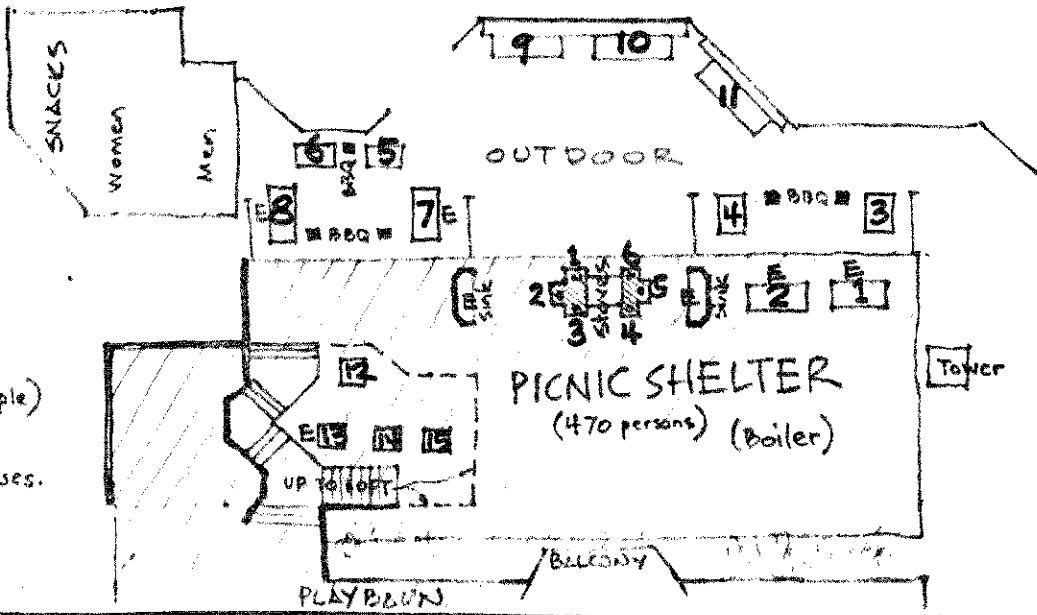
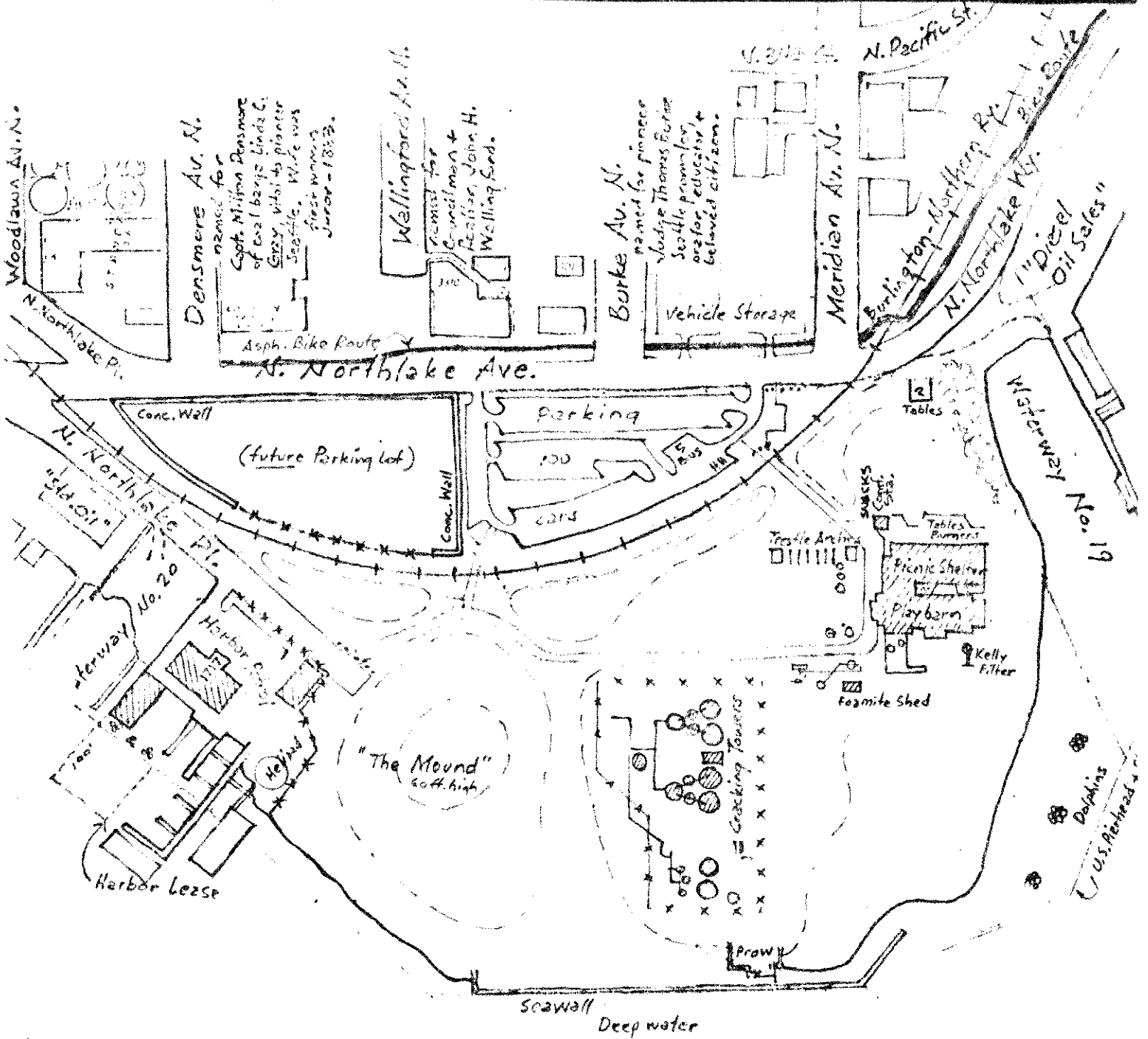

Purchase 1963 - 1973  
1963: \$45,000 (60 bf)  
2 lots fr. Water Dept.  
1963-73: \$1,336,352 (GF, Pk. Fd., FT) fr. Seattle Gas Co. - 10 yr. contract  
1964: \$37,000 (60 bf) & \$120,500 - Harbor Patrol - 30% H.U.D. funds

Acreage: 20.75, incl. 0.6 ac. submerged shoreline & 0.25 ac. harbor lease

Development: 1971 master plan, Rich. Haag Assc. Phase I Stage 1, 2 - \$3,262,000 (2,552,000 FT, 710,000 CDBG) completed 1976.  
Stage 3: \$368,000 (8,000 FT, 360,000 CDBG) completed 1978.

Elements: picnic shelter - 13,000 sq. ft., play barn - 11,000 sq. ft., mound & amphitheater, sundial on mound (C. Greening, K. Lazare - artists 1978), mural (S. Singh - 1978)
