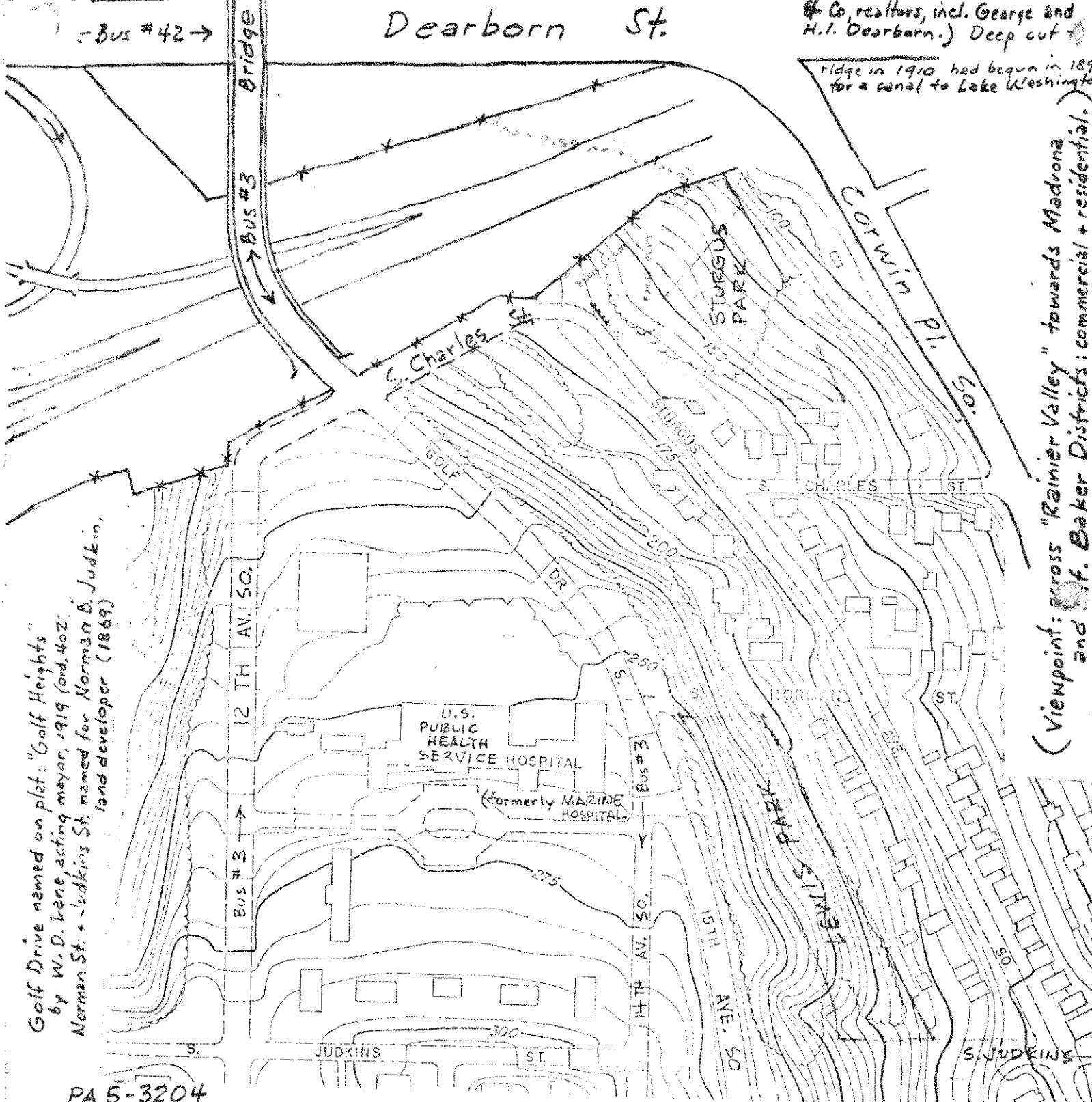

 west of here. (H. H. Dearborn  
 & Co, realtors, incl. George and  
 H. I. Dearborn.) Deep cut



Golf Drive named on plot: "Golf Heights"  
 by W. D. Lane, acting mayor, 1919 (and 402).  
 Norman St. + Judkins St. named for Norman B. Judkin,  
 land developer (1869)

ridge in 1910 had begun in 189  
 for a canal to Lake Washington

(Viewpoint: cross "Rainier Valley" towards Madrona  
 and of Baker Districts: commercial + residential.)

(Wittler, pres. of James St. Const. Co. + Union Trunk Line, James St. Ry. Co.)

Deed - E. F. Wittler, 1896, name taken from vicinity → **BEACON PL.** 11,575 sq. ft.  
 Named "Wittler Park" by Board in 1922

Gift - W. H. Lewis, 1911, named in his honor → **LEWIS PARK** 1.4 Ac.  
 (see below) "payment" for dirt removed from Beacon Pl.

Plat Dedic. - W. H. Lewis, 1904, tract and street named → **STURGUS PARK** 1.3 Ac.  
 for John J. Sturgus, in 1890s; realtor and agent of W. C. Hill Estate  
 W. H. Lewis + wife + T. S. Lippy were officers of  
 W. C. Hill Brick Co., + Lewis + Wiley Hydraulic Contr.
