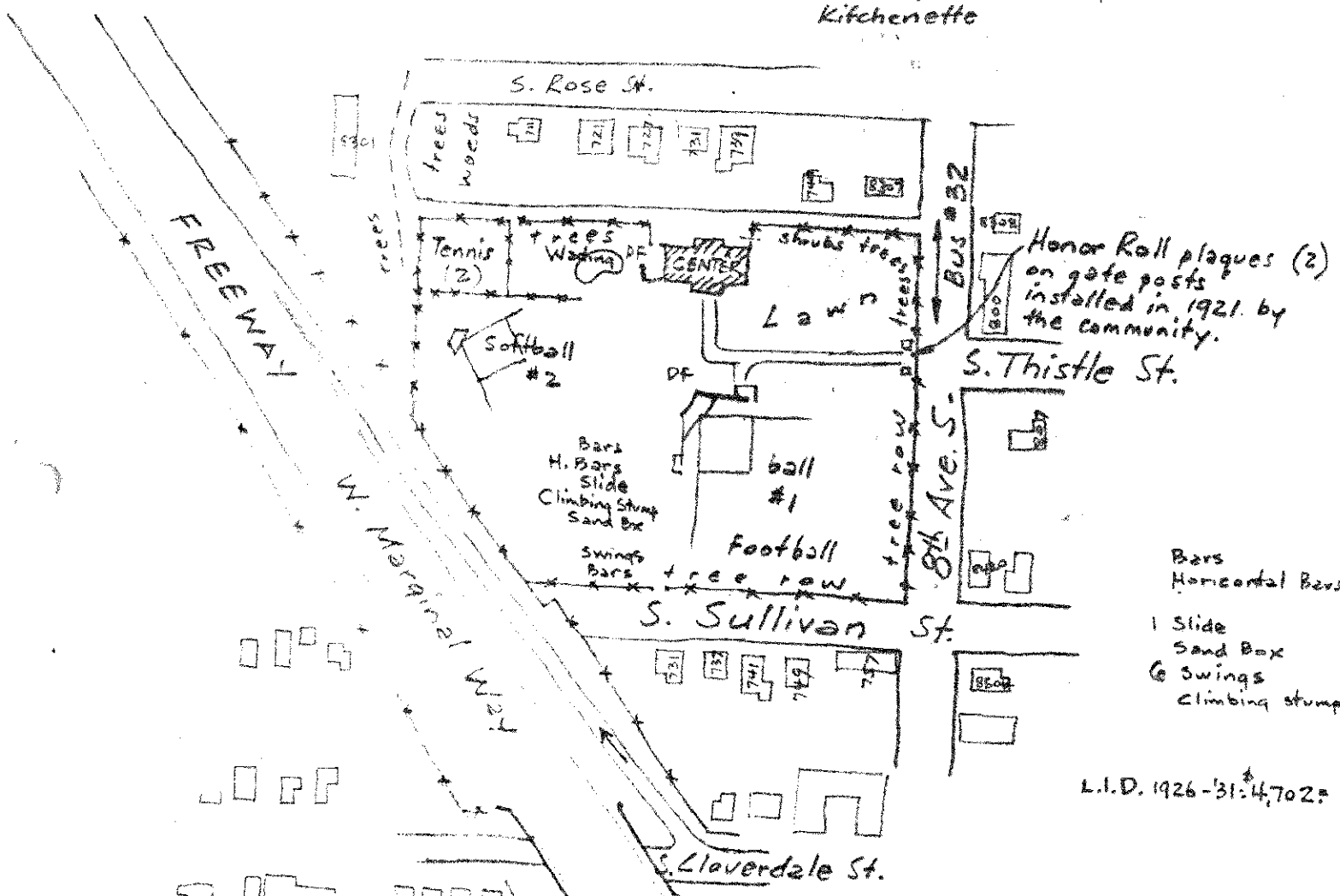


Thistle St. honors the national flower of Scotland

Name taken from early town founded prior to 1894 on the Duwamish River, on a Land Donation Claim in 1865 by John + Eva Buckley. About 1900 Joe Desimone bought a large farm tract of this rich river valley: he was instrumental in formation of the Seattle Public Market, Inc. (Pike Place Market) and his gift of property induced Boeing to establish here rather than in Calif. The community, led by Tony Ferrucci, was able to convince Freeway engineers to "miss" the playground.
