ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE to prohibit smoking on or within street cars while used for the carrying of passengers within the City of Seattle, except under certain conditions, and providing penalties for violations of the provisions hereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it shall be, and is hereby declared, unlawful for any person, while riding on or within any street car of any kind or character while used for the carrying of passengers within the City of Seattle, to smoke a pipe, cigar or cigarette, except in such portions or compartment of the car as may have been designated and set aside for smoking purposes, such compartment or area to be so partitioned off as will effectually prevent smoke from coming in contact with other portions of said cars.

Section 2. That any person found guilty of a violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction, shall be fined in any sum not exceeding one hundred (100) dollars, or imprisoned in the city jail for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days, or may be both fined and imprisoned.

Section ³ This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
