AN ORDINANCE Amending Ordinance No. 24597 entitled, "An Ordinance regulating travel and traffic on the streets of the City of Seattle, providing penalties for the violation thereof, and repealing ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith," approved July 14, 1910.

Be it Ordained by The City of Seattle, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 24597 entitled, "An Ordinance regulating travel and traffic on the streets of the City of Seattle, providing penalties for the violation thereof, and repealing ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith," approved July 14, 1910," be, and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be known and designated as Section 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  and to read as follows:

Section 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ . It shall be unlawful for any pedestrian to cross, except at street intersections, any of the following named streets and avenues, to-wit:

First, Second, Third and Fourth Avenues, each from Yesler Way to Pine Street; Pike Street and Pine Street, each from First Avenue to Eighth Avenue.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section ..... This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
