ORDINANCE No. 10.

An Ordinance in Relation to Closing  
Saloons and Places of Business.

The City of Seattle does ordain as follows:  
That the front doors of all Saloons and Drinking  
Houses shall be, and remain closed on Sundays.  
Also, all places of business shall be closed from ten  
o'clock, a. m., to four o'clock, p. m., excepting  
hotels and drug stores.

Any person guilty of violating this Ordinance, on  
conviction shall be fined in a sum not exceeding  
twenty-five dollars.
