### ORDINANCE 100118

AN ORDINANCE providing for the acquisition by condemnation of land and other property in Block 63, A. A. Denny's 5th Addition to the City of Seattle for park, recreation, and general corporate purposes.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That public convenience and necessity demand that the following described real property:

All air rights lying at or above an elevation of 202 feet above mean sea level, City of Seattle datum, appurtenant to the following described property:

SUBJECT TO the right to construct and maintain structural support upon said portion of Lots 2 and 3 sufficient to allow full utilization of said air rights for park, recreation and open space.

together with all rights, privileges, and other property pertaining thereto be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated and taken for public use, namely for general corporate purposes.

Section 3. Said lands, rights, privileges, and other property are to be so appropriated and taken only after just compensation has been made or paid into court to the owners thereof in the manner provided by law.

Section 4. That the entire cost of the acquisition provided for in Section 1 of this ordinance shall be paid from the Park Acquisition and Development Fund or from such other general fund of the City of Seattle as may be provided by law.

Section 5. That the entire cost of the acquisition provided for in Section 2 of this ordinance shall be paid from the General Fund or from such other general funds of The City of Seattle as may be provided by law.

## (To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 6. That the Corporation Cornwel is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute proceedings in the manner provided by law to condemn, take, damage, and appropriate the lands and property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance and stipulate for the purpose of minimizing damages.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
