ORDINANCE 102215

AN ORDINANCE transferring partial jurisdiction over certain City (Department of Parks and Recreation) property in Calligan and Coryell's Addition and in the northeast one-quarter of the southwest one-quarter of Section 28, Township 25 North, Range 4 East, W.M., and in vacated 20th Avenue East, and in vacated East Harrison Street, to the Engineering Department to permit construction and maintenance of a storm drain with appurtenances.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer and the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation have recommended (C.F. 275459) the transfer of partial jurisdiction over certain property acquired for Park and Recreation purposes pursuant to Ordinances 23268 and 80463, to the Engineering Department for the construction and maintenance of a storm drain with appurtenances through said property and having determined that the benefits to the servient park property from installation of a storm drain approximate in value the rights and privileges transferred; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That such limited and partial jurisdiction as shall be necessary for the construction and maintenance of a storm drain with appurtenances over the following described property:

A 12-foot strip of land over and across a portion of Block 3, Calligan and Coryell's Addition, as recorded in Volume 5 of Plats, page 84, records of King County, Washington, and of the northeast one-quarter of the southwest one-quarter of Section 28, Township 25 North, Range 4 East, W.M., and of vacated 20th Avenue East, and of vacated East Harrison Street lying 6 feet on each side of a line described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the center lines of East Republican Street and 20th Avenue East; thence south 0°57'12" west along the center line of 20th Avenue East 172.32 feet; thence north 89°22'48" west 21.00 feet to the true point of beginning; thence south 0°57'12" west 156.99 feet; thence south 22°50'04" west 51.00 feet; thence south 0°57'23" west 306.52 feet; thence south 2°05'09" east 281.44 feet to the terminus at the intersection with the south vacation line of 20th Avenue East, which is north 89°26'30" west 25.24 feet and north 2°05'09" west 29.96 feet from the intersection of the center lines of East Thomas Street and 20th Avenue East.

is hereby transferred from the Department of Parks and Recreation to the Engineering Department subject to the following conditions:

- (1) The Engineering Department, at project expense, shall use reasonable methods to protect the Department of Parks and Recreation property from damage and the

users thereof from injury and shall restore the property herein described as nearly as possible to its original condition after construction; and

- (2) The Engineering Department shall give the Department of Parks and Recreation reasonable notice before work is commenced.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
