ORDINANCE 102222

AN ORDINANCE transferring jurisdiction over certain City (Department of Lighting) property situated within the boundaries of the existing Hamlin Park to the Department of Parks and Recreation for park purposes, and making an appropriation from the Park Acquisition and Development fund therefor.

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation has recommended (C.F. 275306) the transfer of jurisdiction over certain City (Lighting Department) property acquired pursuant to Ordinance 82201 and now surplus to the present and future needs of the Lighting Department to the Park Department for park purposes, and the Lighting Department and Department of Parks and Recreation have agreed as to a true and fair value of \$500 as to said property; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That upon payment to the Light Fund from the Park Acquisition and Development Fund as contemplated herein, jurisdiction over the following described property located in King County, Washington:

The south 50 feet of the east 100 feet of the west 230 feet of the northwest 1/4 of the northwest 1/4 of Section 16, Township 26 north, Range 4 east, W.M.

is hereby transferred from the Department of Lighting to the Department of Parks and Recreation for park purposes as contemplated by King County Resolution 34571, Section 3(E) (1), as recommended by the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation in C.F. 275306, and for such purpose the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated from the Park Acquisition and Development Fund; and the City Comptroller is authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants and make the necessary transfers.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
