AN ORDINANCE transferring partial jurisdiction over certain City (general municipal purpose) property in Block 173, Gilman's Addition, to the Engineering Department for storm drain and sanitary sewer purposes.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer and the Superintendent of Buildings have recommended (C.F. 275819) the transfer of partial jurisdiction over certain property acquired for general municipal purposes pursuant to Ordinances 36168 and 88399, to the Engineering Department for the construction and maintenance of a storm drain and sanitary sewer with appurtenances through said property and have determined that the benefits to the servient property approximate in value the rights and privileges transferred; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That such limited and partial jurisdiction as shall be necessary for construction and maintenance of a storm drain and sanitary sewer with appurtenances over the following described property:

The north ten (10) feet of Lot 18 and the north ten (10) feet of Lot 29, all in Block 173, Gilman's Addition, as recorded in Volume 5 of Plats, page 93, records of King County, Washington,

is hereby transferred from the Building Department to the Engineering Department subject to the following conditions:

(1) The Engineering Department, at project expense, shall use reasonable methods to protect the property herein described from damage and the users thereof from injury and shall restore such property as nearly as possible to its original condition after construction; and

(2) The Engineering Department shall give the Building Department reasonable notice before work is commenced.

Section...2.. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
