ORDINANCE 102664

AN ORDINANCE providing for a landslide control project in the 5200 Block of Southwest Jacobson Road, making a reimbursable appropriation from the Emergency Fund and declaring the emergency therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Engineer in accordance with plans and specifications prepared therefor pursuant to Ordinance 101975 is hereby authorized to proceed under the direction of the Board of Public Works with certain construction referred to as the landslide control project in the 5200 Block of Southwest Jacobson Road, which project may be effected by the awarding of a contract or contracts therefor, or the same or any part thereof may be effected by day labor, in the discretion of said Board; and for such purposes the sum of Forty-three Thousand Seven Hundred Forty Dollars (\$43,740) or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated from the Emergency Fund, reimbursable by an appropriation in like amount hereby made from the Arterial City Street Fund; all as recommended by the City Engineer and Mayor in C.P. 276717, and the City Comptroller is authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants and make the necessary transfers.

Section 2. WHEREAS, the appropriation herein made is to meet actual necessary expenditures of the City for which no appropriation has been made due to causes which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making the 1973 Budget; Now, Therefore, in accordance with RCW 35.32A.060, by reason of the facts above stated and the emergency which is hereby declared to exist, this ordinance shall become effective

immediately upon the approval or signing of the same by the Mayor or passage over his veto, as provided by the Charter of the City.

PASSED by three-fourths vote of all the members of the City Council the 9 day of October, 1973, and signed by me in open session in authentication of its passage this 9 day of October, 1973.
