

ORDINANCE 102206

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Engineering Department; authorizing the preparation of plans, specifications, cost estimates for, and the construction of certain projects in the Arterial Wire Undergrounding Program, and making an appropriation from the Arterial Development Fund therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Engineer is authorized and directed to prepare plans, specifications and cost estimates for the following projects in the Arterial Wire Undergrounding Program:

1. Southwest Roxbury Street, Unit C, 18th Avenue Southwest to 24th Avenue Southwest and 28th Avenue Southwest to 35th Avenue Southwest.
2. Westlake Avenue North from Valley Street to the Fremont Bridge.
3. Rainier Avenue South from South Jackson Street to Empire Way South.
4. Northwest Market Street and Northwest 54th Street, both from 15th Avenue Northwest to 32nd Avenue Northwest.
5. 35th Avenue Northeast from Northeast 65th Street to Northeast 85th Street.
6. Lake City Way Northeast from Northeast 110th Street to Northeast 145th Street.

and in such connection is authorized to employ consultants where required, and upon approval of such plans, specifications and cost estimates, is authorized to proceed under the direction of the Board of Public Works with the construction of the foregoing projects and the construction of the Aurora Avenue North Project on Aurora Avenue North from Denny Way to the south abutment of the Aurora Bridge, plans for which were prepared pursuant to Ordinance 99236. Each of such improvements may be effected by the awarding of a contract or contracts therefor or the same or any part thereof may be effected by day labor in the discretion of said Board, and for such plans, specifications, estimates and construction costs the sum of Two Million One Hundred Thirty-four Thousand Five Hundred

Eighty-three Dollars (\$2,134,583) is hereby appropriated from the Arterial Development Fund and the City Comptroller is authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants and make any necessary transfers, all as requested by the City Engineer and recommended by the Mayor in C.F. 278535.

Section 2. That any act pursuant to the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
