BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That as recommended by the Superintendent of Lighting and the Mayor in C.F. 281792, the Mayor and the City Comptroller are hereby authorized to execute for and on behalf of the City an agreement with the State of Washington substantially in the form of the "Permit Agreement" contained in C.F. 281792, granting a permit for a term of ten years to construct, operate and maintain a communication terminal building on City property in Newhalem and radio communication facilities in the City's transmitter building and tower at Ross Dam, renewable entirely at the City's option upon application by the State for an additional ten year period, subject to such terms and conditions as the City may prescribe at the time of renewal; provided that before execution of said Permit Agreement Section II (c) thereof shall be amended to read as follows:

"(c) This Agreement may be amended at any time during the original or renewed term by mutual written Agreement of the City and the State, subject to approval by ordinance of the City."
