ORDINANCE 104728

AN ORDINANCE relating to and retitling and reclassifying employee positions in the Engineering and Parks and Recreation Departments, fixing compensation and providing payment therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That as of April 1, 1975, as contemplated in Civil Service Classification Report No. 26-75, employee positions in the designated City departments are hereby retitled and reclassified as follows:

Engineering Department

(1) Associate Landscape Architect retitled and reclassified to (1) Senior Landscape Architect at the salary rate of \$1328 - 1380 - 1436 - 1494 - 1553 per month.

(1) Senior Landscape Architect retitled and reclassified to (1) Chief Landscape Architect at the salary rate of \$1494 - 1553 - 1615 - 1679 - 1746 per month.

Parks and Recreation Department

(2) Associate Landscape Architect retitled and reclassified to (2) Senior Landscape Architect at the salary rate of \$1328 - 1380 - 1436 - 1494 - 1553 per month.

(1) Senior Landscape Architect retitled and reclassified to (1) Chief Landscape Architect at the salary rate of \$1494 - 1553 - 1615 - 1679 - 1746 per month.

at the salary rates indicated and for such compensation the respective department heads are authorized to use unencumbered and unexpended salary funds accumulating in the 1975 budgets of the respective departments.

Section 2. Any act pursuant to the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.



Dear Mrs. Williams:

Civil Service Classification Report No. 26-75 establishes new class titles and specifications for positions currently titled Assistant, Associate, and Senior Landscape Architect in the Engineering and Parks Departments. In addition to updating the position allocations and class specifications, the classification review and report deals with the recently instituted State requirement for registration of Landscape Architects.

The new specification establishes the class title as Landscape Architect and provides for assignment to the levels of Senior Landscape Architect and Chief Landscape Architect. Position allocation titles are:

<u>FROM</u>	<u>TO</u>
Assistant Landscape Architect*	Landscape Architect
Associate Landscape Architect	Senior Landscape Architect
Senior Landscape Architect	Chief Landscape Architect

* Positions titled Assistant Landscape Architect are included in the Technical Engineers, Local 17 bargaining unit.

All of the foregoing titles now require registration as Landscape Architect in the State of Washington. A new entry level job class titled "Landscape Designer" was adopted in Classification Report No. 102-75. One Assistant Landscape Architect position and one Associate Landscape Architect position being filled as Assistant Landscape Architect in lieu thereof in the Engineering Department were allocated to this new class.

July 8, 1975

In implementation of the classification action, it is recommended that adjustments be provided to establish salary for the new class titled Senior Landscape Architect equal to that now provided for Associate Engineer and for the new class titled Chief Landscape Architect, a salary equated to that of Senior Engineer. The union-represented class now titled Assistant Landscape Architect is at the same pay level as Assistant Civil Engineer I. Implementation of title change for the existing class of Assistant Landscape Architect is not recommended at this time since such title change is subject to negotiation with the authorized bargaining representative.

Following are comparative present and proposed salary changes:

<u>Present Title</u> <u>(Salary Range)</u>	<u>Proposed Title</u> <u>(Salary Range)</u>
Assistant Landscape Architect (\$1090 - 1179)	No change - Bargaining Unit Civil Service Title - Landscape Architect
Associate Landscape Architect (\$1153 - 1328)	Senior Landscape Architect (\$1328 - 1553)
Senior Landscape Architect (\$1407 - 1646)	Chief Landscape Architect (\$1494 - 1746)

It is recommended that legislation be initiated, establishing the new titles and salaries and reclassifying the non-represented positions in the Engineering and Parks Departments, as detailed in the attached proposed legislation.
