ORDINANCE 104776

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Department of Parks and Recreation and the Engineering Department; authorizing construction of the Elliott Bay Park Bikeway, and the planting of trees, installation of landscaping, and the construction of a pedestrian path in Alaskan Way from Bay Street to West Thomas Street, in West Thomas Street from Alaskan Way to Elliott Bay, and in Bay Street from Alaskan Way to Elliott Bay; and the erection of fencing along Alaskan Way from Bay Street to West Thomas Street, making a reimbursable appropriation from the Emergency Fund and declaring the emergency therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That as requested by the City Engineer and recommended by the Mayor in C.F. 281752, the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation in consultation with the City Engineer upon approval by the Board of Public Works of plans prepared therefor pursuant to Ordinance 102864, is authorized to proceed under the direction of said Board with the construction of the Elliott Bay Park Bikeway and the planting of trees, installation of landscaping, and construction of a pedestrian path, all in Alaskan Way from Bay Street to West Thomas Street, in West Thomas Street from Alaskan Way to Elliott Bay and in Bay Street from Alaskan Way to Elliott Bay, and to erect fencing along the west side of the Burlington Northern Railroad tracks from Bay Street to West Thomas Street to separate bicycle/pedestrian traffic from train traffic. Such improvement may be effected by the awarding of a contract or contracts therefor or the same or any part thereof may be effected by day labor in the discretion of said Board, and for such purpose the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated from the Emergency Fund, reimbursable by the appropriation hereby made and authorized of a like amount from the City Street Fund, which fund shall in turn

1 be reimbursable from the Arterial City Street Fund to the
2 extent that the State of Washington, Department of Highways
3 authorizes such reimbursement, and should said streets at
4 some future time be designated parkway, park drive, or boule-
5 vard pursuant to RCW 35.21.190, the appropriations herein made
6 from the City Street Fund and the Arterial City Street Fund
7 shall be reimbursable by appropriations from the Park Acquisition
8 and Development Fund for any expenditures made for the purposes
9 contemplated by this ordinance, and the City Comptroller is
10 authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary
warrants and make any necessary transfers.

11 Section 2. WHEREAS, the appropriation herein made is
12 to meet actual necessary expenditures of the City for which
13 no appropriation has been made due to causes which could not
14 reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making the 1975
15 Budget; Now, Therefore, in accordance with RCW 35.32A.060,
16 by reason of the facts above stated and the emergency which
17 is hereby declared to exist, this ordinance shall become
18 effective immediately upon the approval or signing of the
19 same by the Mayor or passage over his veto, as provided by
the Charter of the City.

20 PASSED by three-fourths vote of all the members of the
21 City Council the 28 day of July, 1975, and
22 signed by me in open session in authentication of its passage
23 this 28 day of July, 1975.
