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ORDINANCE 104924

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Seattle Model City Program; providing for the acceptance of certain assets that belonged to The Administrative Commission, and making an appropriation and transfer of a portion thereof to the Pike Place Market Preservation and Development Authority and to the Historic Seattle Preservation and Development Authority in order to further Model City Program purposes.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 100495 and RCW 35.21.660 - .670, The City of Seattle established The Administrative Commission, a public corporation, to assist in the implementation of the City's Grant Agreement with the United States of America, Department of Housing and Urban Development dated August 1, 1969, contained in C.F. 264621 entitled "Grant Agreement for a Comprehensive City Demonstration Program" (called the "Grant Agreement" herein); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 103387, The Administrative Commission, by resolution of its Board of Commissioners dated February 18, 1975, appointed its president and legal counsel "to coordinate and consummate" its dissolution, directed that all cash and assets in excess of its liabilities other than its assets devoted to the land bank project be returned to The City of Seattle through its Model City Program, and filed dissolution papers cancelling its charter, and the charter of the same was cancelled on or before May 1, 1975; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 100495, The City of Seattle established the Pike Place Market Preservation and Development Authority and the Historic Seattle Preservation and Development Authority as public corporations, and, pursuant to Ordinance 103387 and RCW 35.21.725 - .755, such public corporations will continue in existence, and have promised to use any moneys transferred to them in accordance with the conditions and restrictions of the Grant Agreement to implement projects and activities in furtherance of the purposes and objectives of the Demonstration Cities and Metropolitan Development Act of 1966, as amended (P.L. 89-754, 80 Stat. 1255, 42 USC § 3301 et seq.); Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That as contemplated by C.F. 282025 and Ordinances 100495 and 103387, the Mayor is hereby authorized to accept for and on behalf of The City of Seattle such monies as the President of The Administrative Commission, acting with the advice and concurrence of its legal counsel,

4 transfer to the City in the course of and as a consequence
5 of its dissolution; to execute an agreement with the Pike
6 Place Market Preservation and Development Authority and the

8 use and expenditure for redevelopment of the Pike Place
9 Market, economic development and historic preservation
10 purposes in accordance with the conditions and restrictions
11 of the City's Grant Agreement with the United States contained
12 in C.F. 264621 and in furtherance of the purposes and objectives
13 of the Demonstration Cities and Metropolitan Development Act
14 of 1966, as amended, of such portion of the monies received
15 and hereby appropriated not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-six
16 Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-three Dollars (\$126,763) as the
17 Director of the Model Cities Program and the Budget Director
18 shall certify for expenditure for said purposes; to transfer
19 to the aforesaid Pike Place Market Preservation and Development
20 Authority and the Historic Seattle Preservation and Development
21 Authority such sums as provided in the said agreement(s);
22 and to deposit all funds received and not so transferred in
23 the Model City Fund; and the City Comptroller is authorized
24 to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants
25 and to make the necessary transfers.

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Section 2. That any act consistent with the authority
and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby
ratified and confirmed.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.




