1 AN ORDINANCE authorizing a collective bargaining agreement
2 with International Union of Operating Engineers, Local
3 286, for the period September 1, 1977, through August
4 31, 1978, and fixing compensation of certain employees
5 effective October 1, 1977.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

7 Section 1. That as requested by the Director of Person-
8 nel and recommended by the Mayor in the materials attached
9 hereto, the Mayor is hereby authorized for and on behalf of
10 the City to execute a collective bargaining agreement with
11 International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 286, for
12 the period September 1, 1977, through August 31, 1978, sub-
13 stantially in the form attached hereto and identified as
14 *
15 "Agreement By and Between City of Seattle and International
16 Union of Operating Engineers, Local 286."

17 Section 2. That as of October 1, 1977, the hourly rates
18 of compensation of the designated positions and assignments
19 in the various City departments shall be as follows:

20 BUILDING OPERATING ENGINEER	\$7.6773-7.9736-8.3027
21 CUSTODIAL ENGINEER II	\$6.9463-7.2229-7.5126
22 STEAM ENGINEER	\$7.5126-7.8156
23 STEAM ENGINEER, SR.	\$8.4477-8.7834

24 and that to pay such compensation department heads are
25 authorized to use unencumbered and unexpended salary funds
26 accumulating in the 1978 Budgets of their respective depart-
27 ments.

28 Section 3. That Salary Ordinance 105117 and other ordi-
nances insofar as inconsistent herewith are hereby superseded.

Section 4. That execution and delivery of the agreement
authorized in Section 1 hereof and any act pursuant to the
authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance
are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section...5.. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

Enclosed is a proposed ordinance authorizing the Mayor to execute the agreement recently negotiated between the City and International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 286, effective September 1, 1977 through August 31, 1978. A copy of this agreement is attached. The original and two copies of the agreement for the Mayor's signature will be forwarded directly to his office following passage and approval of the enclosed ordinance.

The major monetary items negotiated in this labor agreement were an 8.8% across-the-board salary increase, retroactive to October 1, 1977; the City will pay the full cost of the medical/dental premiums for 1978, and such premiums are delineated as the City's maximum liability.
