ORDINANCE 108666

AN ORDINANCE adopting a budget for The City of Seattle for the year 1980.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Annual Budget submitted, as contemplated by RCW Ch. 35.32A, by the Mayor and filed as C.F. 288552 with the following modifications, to wit:

(a) Recommendations of the Mayor for changes in his ~~1979~~ <sup>1980</sup> Proposed Annual Budget as set forth in C.F. ~~288790 A~~ <sup>and</sup> C.F. ~~288790 B~~ <sup>;</sup>

(b) Recommendations of the Budget Committee of the City Council for modification, as adopted by the City Council on ~~December~~ <sup>November 30,</sup> 1979, and set forth in C.F. ~~288791~~ <sup>;</sup> is hereby adopted, and the officer and employee positions designated in said submitted Budget (C.F. ~~288552~~ <sup>;</sup> C.F. ~~288790 A~~ <sup>;</sup> ~~and~~ <sup>and</sup> C.F. ~~288790 B~~ <sup>and 288791</sup> are hereby established in the various departments of The City of Seattle. Should any budget recommendation, modification, adjustment, or amendment conflict, the last adopted shall control and it shall be deemed that the same were adopted in the following order: (1) C.F. ~~288552~~ <sup>;</sup> (2) C.F. ~~288790 A~~ <sup>;</sup> (3) C.F. ~~288790 B~~ <sup>;</sup> (4) C.F. ~~288791~~ <sup>;</sup> ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~

Section 2. Expenditures made or authorized consistent with the authority and prior to the effective dates of this ordinance are hereby ratified and confirmed.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
