ORDINANCE 108769

AN ORDINANCE accepting the donated sculpture by Richard Beyer, entitled "Waiting for the Interurban."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The sculpture by Richard Beyer, entitled "Waiting for the Interurban," presently located on a pedestrian landing in the intersection of Fremont Avenue North and North 34th Street, is hereby accepted.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
