ORDINANCE 110450

AN ORDINANCE amending SMC 3.16.070 to clarify the authority of the Fire Chief to use Fire Department apparatus, equipment and personnel outside of the city limits, and to extend such authority to include the control of hazardous materials incidents.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Seattle Municipal Code § 3.16.070 is amended as follows:

The Chief of the Fire Department is authorized to use ((such)) Fire Department apparatus, equipment and personnel outside the city limits ((as-he-deems-necessary)) for the purpose of extinguishing ((or-aiding-in-the-extinguishing or-control-of-fires-as-recommended-in-C.F.-251442)) or controlling, or aiding in the extinguishing or controlling of, fires, explosions, or hazardous material incidents in accordance with written agreements authorized by ordinance.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

1 AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance 93207 by adding a new section
2 authorizing the Fire Chief to send Fire Department personnel
and equipment outside the City limits to property owned,
3 leased or rented by the City of Seattle, or its utilities.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

4 Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance 93207 is amended to
5 read as follows:

6 "Section 2. The Fire Chief is authorized to respond
7 outside the City limits at his discretion to any and all
8 property owned, leased or rented by the City of Seattle or
9 any of its utilities."

10 Section 2. Ordinance 93207 is further amended by
adding thereto a new Section 3 to read as follows:

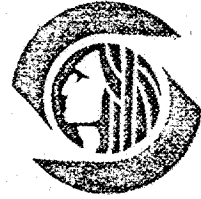
11 "Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be
