ORDINANCE 111176

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Engineering Department; making an appropriation from the Engineering Operating and Arterial City Street Funds for the construction phase of the Northeast 45th Street Viaduct Deck Rehabilitation Project.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. As requested by the Director of Engineering and recommended by the Mayor in the attachments hereto, for construction activities of rehabilitation and resurfacing the center section and west approach of the Northeast 45th Street Viaduct, the expenditure allowance below in the 1983 Budget of the Engineering Department is increased as follows:

and the sum of Six Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$620,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the Engineering Operating Fund to be reimbursed by the appropriation and transfer hereby made and authorized of a like amount from the Arterial City Street Fund. The City Comptroller is authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants and make the necessary transfers.

Section 2. Any act pursuant to the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section <sup>3</sup> This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

**REQUEST.** We request City Council adoption of the attached legislation appropriating \$620,000 from the Arterial City Street Fund for construction activities for the Northeast 45th Street Deck Rehabilitation.

**PURPOSE OF REQUEST.** This legislation provides for the rehabilitation and resurfacing of the deteriorated deck slabs on the center section and west approach of the Viaduct.

**BACKGROUND FACTS.** Resurfacing of the center section of the Viaduct was originally scheduled for mid-1984. A recent investigation of the existing bridge deck revealed exposed reinforcing steel, transverse cracking and exposed aggregate on both the center section and west approach. The Engineering Department has determined that another year of exposure will greatly increase the damage and the cost of repair. Because of the accelerated rate of deterioration, it is necessary to begin rehabilitation in 1983 prior to the winter season, and to expand the project to the west approach. Design work for the construction, authorized in the 1982 CIP, has begun and is being expedited in anticipation of the accelerated construction schedule.

**FUNDING.** The 1982 CIP, Ordinance 110263, Item #32416, appropriated \$100,000 from Arterial City Street Funds for design and pre-construction costs, for the center section.

The 1983 CIP Ordinance 110900 allocates \$500,000 of Arterial City Street fund for construction of the center section. We are requesting an appropriation of this amount plus an additional \$120,000 for construction of the west approach.

The additional \$120,000 appropriation was unanticipated in the 1983 Budget of the Engineering Department; therefore, an increase in the Engineering Department Operating Fund authority is requested for that amount. The appropriation of \$120,000 from the Engineering Operating Fund will be reimbursed by an appropriation of a like amount from the Arterial City Street Fund.

**IMPORTANCE.** A ratify and confirm prior acts clause is included in the attached legislation so that advertising can proceed as scheduled. We would like to begin advertising approximately August 1, 1983.

II. OBJECTIVE

Rehabilitate and resurface the deteriorated deck slabs on the center section and west approach of the viaduct.

III. FISCAL

The 1982 CIP Ordinance 110263, Item 32416, appropriated \$100,000 from ACSF for design and preconstruction costs for the center section. The 1983 CIP Ordinance 110900 allocated \$500,000 of Arterial City Street Fund for construction of the center section. We are requesting an appropriation of this amount plus an additional \$120,000 for construction costs related to the west approach.

IV. PERSONNEL

No new personnel required.

V. EQUIPMENT

No new equipment required.

VI. EVALUATION

Resurfacing of the center section of the viaduct was originally scheduled for mid-1984. A recent investigation of the existing bridge deck revealed exposed reinforcing steel, transverse cracking, and exposed aggregate on both the center section and west approach. The Engineering Department has determined that another year of exposure will greatly increase the damage and the cost of repair; rehabilitation must occur in 1983 prior to the next winter season. The project must be expanded to include the west approach.
