AN ORDINANCE relating to the Federal Shared Revenue Fund as created by Ordinance 101742, eliminating the fund.

WHEREAS the General Revenue Sharing program expired on August 30, 1986 and attempts to get that program reauthorized after that date failed, Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Federal Shared Revenue Fund, created by Ordinance 101742, on January 1, 1973, is hereby closed and eliminated effective December 31, 1986.

Section 2. All assets, liabilities, and any residual fund balance remaining in the Federal Shared Revenue Fund shall be transferred to the General Fund on December 31, 1986; and the City Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to make such transfers.


Section 3. Any act pursuant to the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

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
