ORDINANCE 114019

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AN ORDINANCE transferring partial jurisdiction over certain City (Department of Parks and Recreation) real property in Block 2, West Side Addition to West Seattle, together with portion of vacated 27th Avenue Southwest, and in Section 24, Township 24 North, Range 3 East, W.M., to the Engineering Department for construction and maintenance of a culvert with appurtenances, in conjunction with the Longfellow Creek at Southwest Brandon Street Improvements project (R/W 8712).

WHEREAS, the Director of Engineering has recommended and the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation has concurred in the transfer of partial jurisdiction of the above described real property from the Department of Parks and Recreation to the Engineering Department for construction and maintenance of a culvert with appurtenances; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Engineering and the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation have concurred in this transfer for mutual and offsetting benefits; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. As recommended by the Director of Engineering, such limited and partial jurisdiction as shall be necessary for the construction and maintenance of a culvert, with all necessary appurtenances, over, under, through, across and upon the following described real property in Seattle, King County, Washington:

The west 30 feet of Lot 1, and the west 30 feet of the north 5 feet of Lot 2, Block 2, West Side Addition to West Seattle, according to the plat thereof recorded in Volume 7 of Plats, page 48, Records of King County, Washington; together with portion of the east 20 feet of vacated 27th Avenue Southwest adjoining said portions of said lots on the west.

ALSO,

Portion of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 24, Township 24 North, Range 3 East, W.M., described as follows:

Beginning at the monument in Southwest Brandon Street at its intersection with 27th Avenue Southwest;
Thence west parallel with the south margin of Southwest Brandon Street 25 feet;
Thence north perpendicular to the south margin of Southwest Brandon Street 30 feet to the north margin of Southwest Brandon Street and the True Point of Beginning;
Thence north parallel with the production north of the west margin of 27th Avenue Southwest 50 feet;
Thence east parallel with the north margin of Southwest Brandon Street 55 feet;
Thence south parallel with the production north of the west margin of 27th Avenue Southwest 50 feet to the north margin of Southwest Brandon Street;
Thence west along the north margin of Southwest Brandon Street 55 feet to the True Point of Beginning.

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




Transmitted for City Council approval is a Council Bill transferring partial jurisdiction of certain Department of Parks and Recreation property to the Engineering Department.
