ORDINANCE 114227

AN ORDINANCE amending Section 16.08.050 to make the Waterway Operations and Maintenance Fund a restricted account of the General Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Seattle Municipal Code Section 16.08.050 (Ordinance 87983 § 74 as added by Ordinance 100171 § 18) is amended as follows:

Waterway Operations and Maintenance (~~Fund~~) Account
A (~~special fund~~) restricted account designated the "Waterway Operation and Maintenance Account (~~Fund~~) is established in the General Fund (~~City Treasury~~) to which (~~fund~~) restricted account shall be deposited all fees collected from waterway use and occupation permits issued under this chapter; reimbursement of expenses incurred by the Port Warden in removal, towing, impoundment of vessels, watercraft or obstructions and receipts from sale of such vessels, watercraft or obstructions; its proportionate share of interest earnings of invested General Fund balances; and any other moneys accruing from activities under this title in waterways or appropriated or budgeted to such fund.

The Waterway Operations and Maintenance Account (~~Fund~~) shall be charged with the cost of administration, inspection and policing involved in the issuance and continuance of such permits; activities of the City in maintaining waterways as public ways for watercraft and for commerce and navigation; and for maintaining a reserve to clear waterways of vessels that may sink therein and for emergency activities related to waterways and navigation. Vouchers for expenditures shall be approved by the Director of Engineering or his or her designee.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 2..... This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.


