5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

6 Section 1. Section 6.230.070 F of the Seattle Municipal
7 Code is amended as follows:

8 6.230.070 F Issuance of licenses

9 F. All persons applying for a license or certificate under
10 this chapter shall be examined by the Department of Licenses
11 and Consumer Affairs according to the provisions of Section
12 6.230.100. Upon determination by the Department of Licenses
13 and Consumer Affairs that the applicant has passed the
14 applicable examination and is otherwise qualified under this
15 chapter, including payment by the applicant of the license
16 fee, the Director of Licenses and Consumer Affairs shall
17 issue the license, certificate, or in the case of applica-
18 tion for a boiler supervisor endorsement, endorse the words
19 "boiler supervisor" on the applicant's steam engineer
20 license. In lieu of a qualifying examination, the Director
21 may accept as evidence of meeting the applicable ordinance
22 requirements of Section 6.230.100, a valid and current
23 license issued by the City of Tacoma which maintains a
24 licensing and testing program that, in the judgment of the
25 Director, meets or exceeds City of Seattle requirements.

Section..... This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 6.230.070 F of the Seattle Municipal

Code is amended as follows:

6.230.070 F Issuance of licenses

F. All persons applying for a license or certificate under this chapter shall be examined by the Department of Licenses and Consumer Affairs according to the provisions of Section 6.230.100. Upon determination by the Department of Licenses and Consumer Affairs that the applicant has passed the applicable examination and is otherwise qualified under this chapter, including payment by the applicant of the license fee, the Director of Licenses and Consumer Affairs shall issue the license, certificate, or in the case of application for a boiler supervisor endorsement, endorse the words "boiler supervisor" on the applicant's steam engineer license. In lieu of a qualifying examination, the Director may accept as evidence of meeting the applicable ordinance requirements of Section 6.230.100, a valid and current license issued by the City of Tacoma which maintains a licensing and testing program that, in the judgment of the Director, meets or exceeds City of Seattle requirements.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
