ORDINANCE 114513

AN ORDINANCE relating to exemptions from the Civil Service, amending SMC 4.13.010 to exempt various positions of employment from the Civil Service System by a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective January 1, 1989, SMC 4.13.010 (Section 1 of Ordinance 113579 is amended as follows:

In addition to those positions exempted by statute or City Charter (elected officers, officers appointed pursuant to the City Charter, assistant City attorneys, heads of ~~((departments))~~ employing units, members of boards and commissions established by the City Charter, members of boards and commissions established by ordinance, and library employees), the positions of City employment listed in subsections A through ~~((E))~~ G of this section requiring a particularly high degree of professional responsiveness and individual accountability, or requiring a confidential or fiduciary relationship with the appointing authority, or being judicial positions requiring insulation as a third branch of government, are hereby declared to be exempt from ~~((compliance with))~~ the Seattle Municipal Code~~((,))~~ Chapters 4.04, 4.08, and the rules of the Personnel Department and the Public Safety Civil Service Commission regarding examination, selection, discipline, termination, and appeals.

SUBJECT: Exemptions Ordinance Revision

The attached ordinance is proposed as companion legislation to the proposed Management Compensation Study (MCS) Ordinance. Its essential function is to revise certain exempt position titles so that they will be consistent with the titles established in the MCS Ordinance. The reason for these revisions is that, with a few exceptions, the Management Compensation Study Ordinance changes the City's series of position titles of Director I through XII to more meaningful, position-specific titles. In addition, a number of existing position-specific titles are revised to match their working titles. All but two of the positions on this ordinance are currently exempt, so for these, the ordinance is merely a housekeeping measure. The two positions for which we are proposing exemptions are proposed in the MCS Ordinance to be retitled to director level titles and salary rates, in recognition of revised duties and responsibilities. Specifically, the positions are:

Two additional changes to the existing Exemptions Ordinance are being made to recognize classification actions which have previously been approved by the City Council and were made exempt but not yet included on the Exemptions Ordinance. The first is the addition of Warrant Server Supervisor in the

Municipal Court, a title created in the 1988 Budget. The second is the exempt Confidential Secretary to the Board of Ethics which was reclassified to Staff Assistant on Ordinance #114071 in August, 1988.

SUBJECT: Substitute Pages for the Exemptions Ordinance (C.B. 106950)

On September 20, 1988, we sent the revised Exemptions Ordinance to the Council as a companion piece to the Management Compensation Study (MCS) Ordinance. We revise the Exemptions Ordinance periodically in order to keep it current with title changes and new positions. The September revision was timely because it incorporated changes to position titles that were being proposed on the MCS Ordinance. The MCS Ordinance was held until the completion of the appeal process, and the Exemptions Ordinance (C.B. 106950) was likewise held.

During the appeal process, several positions were added to the MCS, and a number of position title changes were requested by departments and recommended by the Management Compensation Review Committee (MCRC). These title changes have been incorporated into substitute pages (pages 3 through 9) of the Exemptions Ordinance, which have been transmitted to Betty Curneen of your staff. These changes do not affect the title or intent of the ordinance, and none of the position title changes affects the exemption status of any position relative to the September 20 version. The position title changes are being proposed for consistency and descriptive purposes; they are not correlated with whether or not a position's salary level was changed during appeals.

The list below shows the position title that would have been exempted in the 9/20/88 version, and the title now proposed for exemption in the 5/16/89 version.

ORDINANCE 114513

AN ORDINANCE relating to exemptions from the Civil Service, amending SMC 4.13.010 to exempt various positions of employment from the Civil Service System by a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective January 1, 1989, SMC 4.13.010 (Section 1) of Ordinance 113579 is amended as follows:

In addition to those positions exempted by statute or City Charter (elected officers, officers appointed pursuant to the City Charter, assistant city attorneys, heads of ((departments)) employing units, members of boards and commissions established by the City Charter, members of boards and commissions established by ordinance, and library employees), the positions of City employment listed in subsections A through ((E)) G of this section requiring a particularly high degree of professional responsiveness and individual accountability, or requiring a confidential or fiduciary relationship with the appointing authority, or being judicial positions requiring insulation as a third branch of government, are hereby declared to be exempt from ((compliance with)) the Seattle Municipal Code((...)) Chapters 4.04, 4.06, and the rules of the Personnel Department and the Public Safety Civil Service Commission regarding examination, selection, discipline, termination, and appeals.
