ORDINANCE 114523

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Police Department fees and services and amending SMC 3.28.070 to correct an omission made therein by Ordinance 114235.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective January 1, 1989, SMC 3.28.070 is further amended as follows by adding thereto a fee inadvertently omitted when amended by Ordinance 114235.  
3.28.070. Fees for certain records and services.

The Police Department is authorized to collect the following fees from all persons for certain reports or services supplied by the department; provided, there shall be no charge for "criminal records" data provided to "criminal justice agencies" as defined by RCW 10.97; and provided, further, if the Police Chief determines that the department and the person requesting records or services will receive mutually offsetting benefits through exchanges of information, fees may be waived.

A housekeeping bill correcting an omission in the police fees and services law.

Background:

Don Stout of the Law Department forwarded the request to correct an error in codifying police fees and services approved during the 1989 budget process. One service and its fee were inadvertently omitted: The service "Fingerprinting for review of criminal history record (without copy of conviction record)" should be added to the list along with its charge, \$3.50.

This legislation adds the service and its fee to the Seattle Municipal Code to correct the omission.


Dear Council President Smith:
