ORDINANCE 115139

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AN ORDINANCE relating to the Public Health Department; amending Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 10.13 relating to meat, rabbit, poultry and aquatic foods, consolidating the scopes of licenses of MPRAF wrapper and MPRAF salesperson and simplifying the examination therefor; amending Seattle Municipal Code Subsections 10.13.100, 10.13.120.A, 10.13.120.F, 10.13.150.B, 10.13.160.G, 10.13.400, 10.13.410, 10.03.013.A, 10.03.013.D; and repealing 10.13.160.F.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Seattle Municipal Code Subsection 10.13.100.A is amended as follows:

Section 10.13.100 Permits required.

A. General Requirements. No person shall operate or hold itself out as, work or be employed as, or engage in or carry on the business or work of, an MPRAF establishment, a wholesale MPRAF dealer, a meat cutter, an apprentice meat cutter, or an MPRAF wrapper salesperson, (~~((or MPRAF wrapper,))~~) in the City without having a valid, appropriate permit therefor from the City, except a person exempt from the permit requirements of this chapter pursuant to Section 10.13.110(~~(-)~~) hereof.

Section 2. Seattle Municipal Code Subsection 10.13.120.A and 10.13.120.F are amended as follows:

10.13.120 Application for and issuance of permits.

A. General Application Requirements. Every application for a meat cutter's, apprentice meat cutter's, MPRAF wrapper salesperson's, (~~((MPRAF wrapper's,))~~) wholesale MPRAF dealer's, preparer's permit, or MPRAF establishment permit shall be submitted to the Director upon an application form provided by the Department.

F. Granting of Meat Cutter's or MPRAF wrapper Salesperson's Permit Dependent on Examination Passage. Each application for a meat cutter's permit or an MPRAF wrapper salesperson permit shall be subject to a Departmental examination. The MPRAF wrapper salesperson's examination shall test the applicant's knowledge of requirements and good practices regarding the refrigeration, sanitation, and care of MPRAF. The meat cutter's examination

1 meat; and his/her ability, by the senses, to recognize in meat decomposition
2 and other taints and conditions deleterious to health. Each applicant for a
3 meat cutter's permit shall pay to the director the nonrefundable examination
4 fee of \$15.00 prior to taking the examination. If the applicant passes the
5 examination, the Director shall issue the appropriate permit; otherwise, it
6 shall be denied.

7 Individuals possessing an MPRAF permit or MPRAF salesman permit expiring
8 on June 30, 1990, must successfully pass the MPRAF wrapper salesperson
9 examination in order to obtain an MPRAF wrapper salesperson permit. Renewals
10 issued at this time, may at the option of the applicant, have the same
11 expiration date as the applicant's current food and beverage service workers'
12 permit if applicant produces a valid food and beverage service workers'
13 permit at the time of application and examination. For all new MPRAF wrapper
14 salespersons, for MPRAF wrapper salespersons who do not have a current permit
15 or have lost their permit, or for MPRAF wrapper salespersons whose permit has
16 been expired for more than thirty (30) days, the MPRAF wrapper salesperson's
17 permit shall expire two (2) years from date of issue. Applicants renewing
18 after June 30, 1992, are eligible for a five (5) year permit provided they
19 show either a current MPRAF wrapper salesperson's permit or a MPRAF wrapper
20 salesperson's permit that has not been expired longer than thirty (30) days.
21 The fee for an MPRAF wrapper salesperson's permit shall be Five Dollars
22 (\$5.00).

23 Section 3. Seattle Municipal Code Subsection 10.13.150.B is amended as
24 follows:

25 10.13.150 Suspension and revocation of permits.

26 B. Conditions Permitting Permit Suspension Prior to Revocation Hearing.

27 Whenever the reasons assigned for the revocation of the permit include a
28 charge or statement, based upon reasonable grounds for belief, that the
29 premises described in the permit or the fixtures or equipment used therein,
30 have become or are insanitary; or that the permit holder has been convicted of

3 unwrapped or unpackageg MPRAF or an MPRAF food product, who has failed to file
4 with his/her employer a valid food and beverage service worker's permit; or
5 that the permit holder has otherwise failed to comply with the requirements of
6 this chapter or any other ordinance of the City relating to the preparing,
7 processing, or dispensing of MPRAF or MPRAF food products, or to health and
8 sanitation, or any rule or regulation made pursuant thereto, the Director may
9 immediately suspend the authority granted by the permit involved pending a
10 hearing on the revocation thereof. When any permit has been so suspended,
11 such hearing shall be had not more than ten (10) days after the date of
12 suspension.

13 Section 4. Seattle Municipal Code Subsection 10.13.160.F defining MPRAF
14 Wrapper's Permit is hereby repealed.

15 Section 5. Seattle Municipal Code Subsection 10.13.160.G is amended as
16 follows:

17 G. MPRAF Wrapper Salesperson's Permit. A person issued an MPRAF Wrapper
18 Salesperson's permit is authorized to handle, weigh, label, wrap, display,
19 package and dispense fresh and processed MPRAF and MPRAF food products in a
20 permitted wholesale or retail MPRAF shop; to prepare and dispense any fresh
21 aquatic food therefrom to any consumer; and to dispense processed or frozen
22 MPRAF and MPRAF food products therefrom to any consumer; and in a retail
23 processed MPRAF shop, to slice, package and dispense processed MPRAF and MPRAF
24 food products and to dispense processed and frozen MPRAF and MPRAF food
25 products.

26 Section 6. Seattle Municipal Code Subsection 10.13.400 is amended as
27 follows:

28 10.13.400 Sanitation standards for personnel of MPRAF establishments.
29 No person who works in an MPRAF establishment and handles MPRAF or any MPRAF
30 food product, or who undertakes any of the functions of an ((MPRAF wrapper,))

1 engage in any other potentially (~~un~~)insanitary practice or activity where
2 MPRAF or any MPRAF food product is prepared, processed, dispensed or stored.
3 Each such person shall put on clean outer garments in good repair immediately
4 prior to preparing, processing, or otherwise handling MPRAF or MPRAF food
5 products. Each such person shall wash his/her hands with soap and water
6 immediately prior to preparing, processing, dispensing, storing or otherwise
7 handling any MPRAF or MPRAF food product that is not wrapped or otherwise
8 protected against contamination. Each such person shall wear a hair restraint
9 while in any area of an MPRAF establishment where MPRAF or MPRAF food products
10 are being prepared, processed, dispensed, or stored.

11 Section 7. Seattle Municipal Code Subsection 10.13.410 is amended as
12 follows:


13 10.13.410 Food and beverage service worker's permit required. Every
14 person who works for more than thirty (30) days as a meat cutter, apprentice
15 meat cutter, MPRAF wrapper salesperson (~~(MPRAF wrapper,)~~) or wholesale MPRAF
16 dealer or who otherwise handles unwrapped or unpackageg MPRAF or an MPRAF food
17 product shall obtain and file with his/her employer, or where self-employed,
18 shall retain a valid food and beverage service worker's permit. No person
19 shall employ for more than thirty (30) days any meat cutter, apprentice meat
20 cutter, (~~(MPRAF wrapper,)~~) MPRAF wrapper salesperson or wholesale MPRAF dealer
21 or other person whose duties include the handling of unwrapped or unpackageg
22 MPRAF or an MPRAF food product, who has not filed such permit with his/her
23 employer.

24 Section 8. Seattle Municipal Code Subsection 10.03.013.A is amended as
25 follows:

26 10.03.013 Meat, rabbit, poultry and aquatic foods permit, inspection, and
27 examination fees.

28 A. Amount of Permit Fees. The fees for annual permits issued pursuant to
29 Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 10.13 shall be as follows:

30 1. Permit for wholesale MPRAF shop in which one or more persons are

RE: Amendment to Seattle Municipal Code, Chapter 10.13

The enclosed amendment to Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 10.13 relating to meat, rabbit, poultry, and aquatic foods, is intended to clarify the licensing requirements for meat wrappers.

The proposed action will consolidate the "meat wrapper salesman" and "meat wrapper" licenses into one license category - "meat wrapper salesperson." The proposed action will simplify the examination process and will decrease license fee requirements from \$15.00 annually to \$5.00 every five years.

This proposal is in response to complaints from meat industry employees regarding the cost of license fees. Meat industry representatives are in support of and have been involved in drafting this legislation. Similar legislation will be proposed to the King County Board of Health to ensure consistency.

Action on this amendment will be needed before July 1, 1990 which is the annual renewal date for current meat wrapper and meat wrapper salesman licenses. The amendment is consistent with the Department's 1990 adopted budget.

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Section 2. Seattle Municipal Code Subsection 10.13.120.A and 10.13.120.F are amended as follows:

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Individuals possessing an MPRAF permit or MPRAF salesperson permit expiring on June 30, 1990, must successfully pass the MPRAF wrapper salesperson examination in order to obtain an MPRAF wrapper salesperson permit. Renewals issued at this time, may at the option of the applicant, have the same

10.13.410 Food and beverage service worker's permit required. Every person who works for more than thirty (30) days as a meat cutter, apprentice meat cutter, MPRAF wrapper salesperson ~~((MPRAF wrapper,))~~ or wholesale MPRAF dealer or who otherwise handles unwrapped or unpackaged MPRAF or an MPRAF food product shall obtain and file with his/her employer, or where self-employed, shall retain a valid food and beverage service worker's permit. No person shall employ for more than thirty (30) days any meat cutter, apprentice meat cutter, ~~((MPRAF wrapper,))~~ MPRAF wrapper salesperson or wholesale MPRAF dealer or other person whose duties include the handling of unwrapped or unpackaged MPRAF or an MPRAF food product, who has not filed such permit with his/her employer.

Section 4. Seattle Municipal Code Subsection 10.03.013.A is amended as follows:

10.03.013 Meat, rabbit, poultry and aquatic foods permit, inspection, and examination fees.

A. Amount of Permit Fees. The fees for annual permits issued pursuant to Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 10.13 shall be as follows:

1. Permit for wholesale MPRAF shop in which one or more persons are engaged in preparing and processing end/or dispensing MPRAF food products:
 - a. Two or fewer persons so engaged \$500.00
 - b. Three or more persons so engaged \$700.00
2. Wholesale MPRAF dealer's permit \$400.00
3. Retail processed MPRAF shop permit \$ 75.00
4. Permit for retail MPRAF shop in which one or more persons are engaged in preparing, processing, or dispensing MPRAF or MPRAF products:
 - a. One person so engaged \$200.00
 - b. Two or three persons so engaged \$250.00
 - c. Four or more persons so engaged \$300.00
5. MPRAF warehouse permit \$ 75.00
6. Meat cutter's permit, and apprentice meat cutter's permit ~~((for MPRAF salesperson's permit and MPRAF wrapper's permit))~~ \$ 15.00
7. Meat cutter's ~~((MPRAF salesperson's))~~ examination \$ 15.00

Provided, that the fee for any annual permit issued during the period beginning January 1 and ending June 30 of any year, shall be an amount equal to one-half (1/2) of the applicable fee stated above.

Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
