AN ORDINANCE relating to the City Employees' Retirement System, upgrading certain positions and increasing their hourly wages and the salary of the Executive Director; increasing an expenditure allowance and reducing another in the 1990 Budget of the Retirement System; and making a reappropriation therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. As recommended by the Board of Administration of the City Employees' Retirement System in the materials contained in this ordinance file, the following positions in the City Employees' Retirement System are reclassified and retitled with the hourly wage after the effective date of this ordinance as shown:
