ORDINANCE 115552

AN ORDINANCE amending the definition of "immediate family" in the Code of Ethics for City officers and employees (Seattle Municipal Code Section 4.16.030 D) to include a domestic partner.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection D of Seattle Municipal Code

Section 4.16.030 is amended as follows:

D. "Immediate Family" means:

1. A spouse or domestic partner as contemplated by Sections 4.30.010-.020;
2. Any dependent parent, parent-in-law, child, son-in-law, daughter-in-law; or
3. Any parent, parent-in-law, child, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, sibling, uncle, aunt, cousin, niece or nephew residing in the household of the city officer or employee.

Section 2. Use of forms for statement of economic interests pursuant to Seattle Municipal Code Section 4.16.080 requiring reporting in 1991 of interests of domestic partners is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section...3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

AN ORDINANCE amending the definition of "immediate family" in the Code of Ethics for City officers and employees (Seattle Municipal Code Section 4.16.030 D) to include a domestic partner.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection D of Seattle Municipal Code

Section 4.16.030 is amended as follows:

D. "Immediate Family" means:

1. A spouse or domestic partner as contemplated by Sections 4.10.010-020;
2. Any dependent parent, parent-in-law, child, son-in-law, daughter-in-law; or
3. Any parent, parent-in-law, child, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, sibling, uncle, aunt, cousin, niece or nephew residing in the household of the city officer or employee.

Section 2. Use of forms for statement of economic interests pursuant to Seattle Municipal Code Section 4.16.020 requiring reporting in 1991 of interests of domestic partners is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
