BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. SMC 4.13.010 (C.) (Section 1 of Ordinance 114513) is amended as follows:

Subject: Exemption Ordinance

I am forwarding through your office a proposed ordinance to change the title of the Deputy Community Development Director's position to DCD Administrative Services Division Director. I have redefined the role of this position and that of the other two division directors in a way which has eliminated the deputy director's internal management function. The DCD Administrative Services Division Director will be responsible for directing departmental administrative services including budget and finance, accounting, public information, data processing, Design Commission staffing, telecommunications systems and word processing. This position also oversees the administration of the City's Community Development Block Grant/Human Services Program.

The Personnel Department has approved the title and compensation level for the position. I am in the process of filling the position and hope to have it filled by June.

I am forwarding to you a proposed ordinance amending the Seattle Municipal Code 4.13.010-E to change the title of the Deputy Community Development Director's position to DCD Administrative Services Division Director. I have assigned new responsibilities to this position which aligns it with the other division directors. The position reports to me and is responsible for directing and managing the Administrative Services Division. This division provides administrative services to the department, and administers the City's Community Development Block Grant/Human Services Program.


