ORDINANCE 116484

AN ORDINANCE relating to the City Light Department, declaring City Light Department property located in Seattle, Washington, surplus to the City's needs and not required for providing continued public utility services; authorizing the sale by competitive bidding procedures or negotiations of said surplus property and establishing the fair market value therefor.

(P.M. #230408-3-301)

WHEREAS, the real property hereinafter described, is now surplus to the City's needs and is not and will not be used or useful for any City Light Department or other municipal purpose; and the Superintendent of City Light has recommended in the attachments hereto the sale and conveyance thereof following competitive bidding or negotiations; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provision of RCW 35.94.040 and after a public hearing, the following described real property in Seattle, Washington, located at 12651 Occidental Avenue South:

Easterly 100 feet of Lots 26 and 27, Block 12, Cedarhurst Division No. 2, according to Plat recorded in Volume 32 of Plats, Page 3, in King County, Washington.

SUBJECT TO: The right of the public to make all necessary slopes for cuts or fills upon the lots, blocks and tracts of land shown on plat.

is hereby found and declared to be no longer required for providing public utility service and to be surplus to the City's needs.

Section 2. The appraised value of said property is hereby found and declared to be Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00).

Section 3. As requested by the Superintendent of City
Light and recommended by the Mayor in the attachments hereto,
said Superintendent is authorized to offer said surplus
property for sale by competitive bidding procedures
substantially upon the terms, conditions, restrictions and
limitations set forth in the "Invitation for Bids" contained
in the materials attached hereto. The Contracting Services

Administrator of the Public Works and Consultant Contracting Section of the Department of Administative Services is authorized to receive and open said bids. After the bids have been evaluated by the Superintendent, said Superintendent is hereby authorized to execute any such form of deed and/or deed of trust as may be necessary to effectuate the real property sale herein authorized. If no acceptable bids are received for this property, the Superintendent may proceed with a negotiated sale as stated in Section 4.

Section 4. Recognizing that some properties may not sell through the bid process and that the value of property may vary within a range of the appraisal, the Superintendent is authorized, in the event that no acceptable bids are received for this property, to negotiate a sale within 10% of the appraised value.

Section 5. Proceeds from the sale of the property shall be deposited in the Light Fund.

Section 6. Any act pursuant to the authority of this ordinance and prior to its effective date is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

Proposed Sale of Surplus Hazel Substation - P.M. #230408-3-301

City Light requests enactment of the necessary legislation for disposal by public bid or negotiated sale of the Hazel Substation, located at 12651 Occidental Avenue South.

This property was acquired in 1957 for use as a distribution substation. Due to the conversion of City Light facilities from 4 kV to 26 kV, the substation site is no longer needed.

The Real Estate Services unit has circulated the information on the property to other City departments and government agencies. They are not interested in this site.

City Light recommends that after a public hearing, legislation be passed declaring the property surplus, allowing City Light to proceed with the disposition of the property according to the attached "Invitation for Bid" or through a negotiated sale per the attached Ordinance.

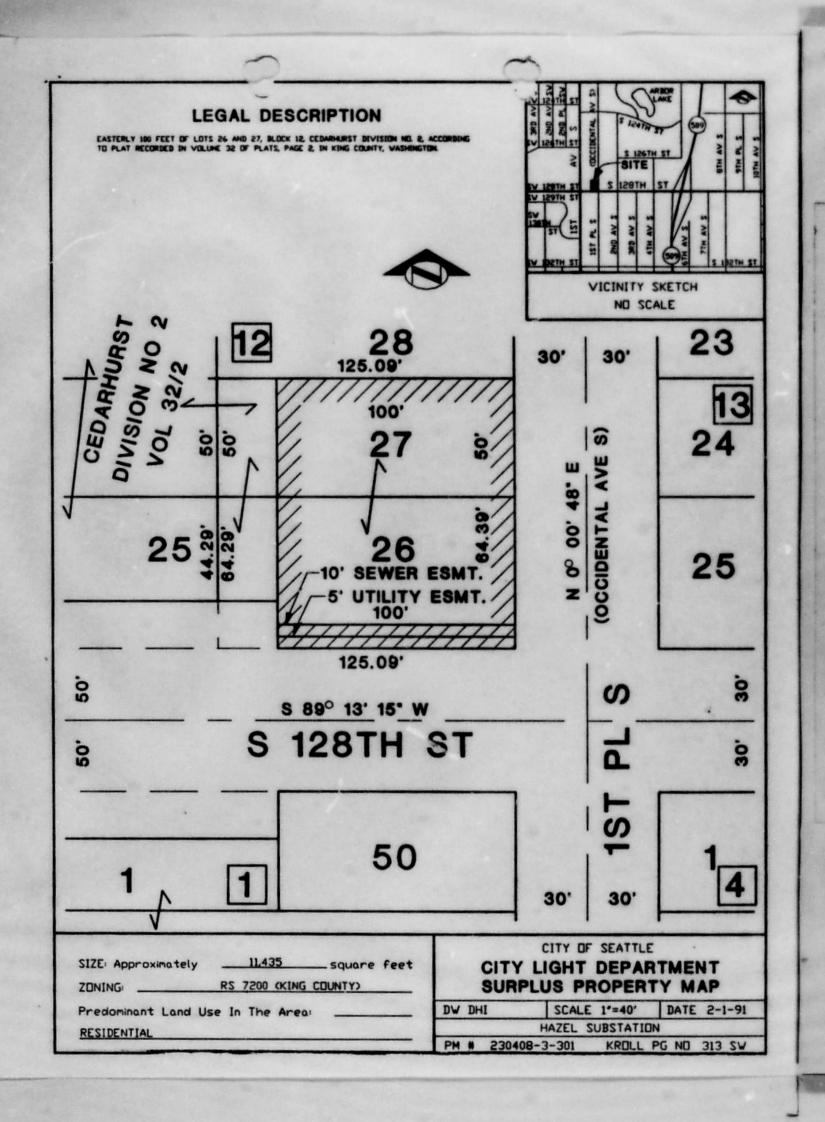

Date of Bid Opening:

The real estate is legally described as follows:

Easterly 100 feet of Lots 26 and 27, Block 12, Cedarhurst Division No. 2, according to Plat recorded in Volume 32 of Plats, Page 3, in King County, Washington.

No bids will be considered for less than the minimum bid price of \$30,000.00.

Successful bidders may purchase by note and Deed of Trust or for the full price in cash. Terms shall include 20% of the bid price as down payment with the balance payable in ten equal annual installments, together with interest at 8% on the declining balance with option to pay the balance at any time.

No bids will be considered unless accompanied by cash, certified or bank cashier's check payable to the City of Seattle, in the sum of not less than 20% of the bid price, which payment shall be security for the performance of such bid and shall be held for liquidated damages in case the successful bidder fails to comply with the bid terms. Deposits of unsuccessful bidders will be returned as soon as possible after the bids have been evaluated. This may take as long as two weeks.

Property is sold "as is" and is subject to existing encumbrances. The City of Seattle takes no responsibility and makes no warranty as to the condition and suitability of the property for any purpose. The purchaser is responsible for ascertaining the usefulness and condition of the property. All assessments, if any, will be assumed by the purchaser. Bids are to be in a sealed separate envelope marked "Bid, Hattel Substation." Successful bidder will pay recording fees and may obtain title insurance, if desired. The sale must be closed within 30 days after approval of the bid by the Superintendent of City Light.

Environmental assessment reports are available for review at the Seattle City Light, Environment, Health and Safety Division, 1111 Third Avenue, Room 325, Seattle, Washington. Arrangements to view these documents may be made by calling Terry Kakida at (206) 386-4582. The City makes no warranty or representations regarding the adequacy or accuracy of these reports. The City has no knowledge of contamination on the site above applicable clean-up levels. The purchaser will be required to waive all claims and release the City from all liability associated in any way with contamination, hazardous substances, wastes, or materials used or on the site, as provided in a release agreement. If financing is provided by the City of Seattle, the purchaser shall be required to comply with all environmental laws during the term of the Deed of Trust and indemnify the City if the failure to do so results in liability.
