# ORDINANCE NO. 116935

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Public Health Department; amending SMC 10.03.130 to change Departmental fees for personal health services.

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Effective January 1, 1994, Seattle Municipal Code ("SMC") 10.03.130 (§ 3 of Ordinance 110272, as last amended by § 1 of Ordinance 115423) is further amended as follows:

10.03.130 Fees for personal health care and dental services.

A. General Fees Established: Fees for health care services authorized in SMC 10.60.010 are hereby fixed and established as the indicated maximum allowable reimbursement levels under Title XIX of the Social Security Act as amended, rounded to the nearest dollar, for the indicated units of service, as specified in the then current Schedule of Maximum Allowances and Program Descriptions published ((August, 1989,)) by the State of Washington, Department of Social and Health Services, Division of Medical Assistance, (three (3))) one (1) ((copies)) copy of each of which documents ((have)) has been filed with the City Clerk ((as)) in C.F. 297801 which schedule is hereby adopted and, by this reference, made a part of this section; provided, that fees for dental services authorized in SMC 10.60.010, are hereby fixed and established as the indicated maximum allowable reimbursements levels under Title XIX of the Social Security Act as amended, rounded to the nearest dollar, for the indicated units of service, as specified in the then current Schedule of Maximum Allowances and Program Descriptions published ((September, 1988)) by the State of Washington, Department of Social and Health Services, Division of Medical Assistance, ((three (3))) one (1) ((copies)) copy of which ((have)) has been filed with the City Clerk ((as)) in C.F. 297802, which schedule is hereby adopted and, by this reference, made a part of this section; provided, further, that fees for HIV Intervention Services authorized in SMC 10.60.010, providing early medical intervention/treatment to HIV seropositive low income persons, are hereby fixed and established as the indicated maximum allowable reimbursement rate under RCW 70.24.250 and RCW 43.20A.550 and Washington State Administrative Code Chapter 248-168 for the indicated units of service as specified in the then current HIV Intervention Program Operations

and Billing Manual published ((July, 1990)) by the State of Washington, Department of Health, one (1) copy of which has been filed with the City Clerk as C.F. 298033, which schedule is hereby adopted and, by this reference, made a part of this subsection, less the adjustment specified by the Department of Health for each eligible recipient; and except the family planning annual visit fee is fixed and established as the maximum Title XIX allowable charges for E/M code 99204 or 99215; provided, further, that treatment of chlamydia fees shall be waived at sites within the Department that receive federal funding to subsidize this treatment; provided, further, that in the event the State Department of Social and Health Services, or its successor, publishes any new or revised Schedule of Maximum Allowances or the State Department of Health, or its successor, publishes a new or revised HIV Intervention Program Operations or Billing Manual, ((and no different fee has been established pursuant to subsection B hereof,))then the Director of Public Health, after making and filing a finding by said Director that such new or revised Schedule is consistent with State guidelines for the establishment of such schedules and filing one (1) copy of such new or revised Schedule with the City Clerk, which copy is adopted and made a part of this section by this reference, shall charge and collect, as the Department's fee, the maximum allowable reimbursement set forth in such new or revised Schedule.

Fee Adjustments: Except as is provided in SMC 10.03.130 F and except for the Department of Health-imposed sliding fee scale for HIV Intervention Program services, and except as mandated by Title X Federal Guidelines for sliding fee scales for Family Planning clinics, the Director of Public Health is authorized to charge and collect reduced fees for the

personal health care and dental services authorized to be performed under SMC 10.60.010, according to the following schedule:

- C. The Director of Public Health is authorized to waive the fees established by this section, for care provided to any recipient who demonstrates, or on whose behalf a demonstration is given, to the reasonable satisfaction of the Director, that such recipient is unable to pay such fees, or when the Director determines that such services are necessary to avert or control a current public health problem.
- D. The term "CSA Poverty Guidelines," as used in subsection C, hereof, means the "poverty income guidelines" applicable to the State of Washington, as published in the Federal Register, Vol. ((55)), 58, No. ((33)), 28 pg. ((5666)) 8287.9, effective ((February 16, 1990)) February 12, 1993, ((three (3))) one (1) ((eopies)) copy of which, together with related information, ((have))has been filed with the City Clerk ((as))in C.F. 298004, and which guidelines are hereby adopted and, by this reference, made a part hereof; provided, that in the event the Federal Government publishes any new or revised poverty guidelines and no different poverty guidelines have been established by the City Council, then the term "CSA Poverty Guidelines" shall mean such new or revised poverty income guidelines, upon the filing of one (1) copy of the same with the City Clerk.
- E. No Fee for Treatment of Certain Sexually-Transmitted Diseases: Notwithstanding any provision in subsection A or B, hereof, to the contrary, the Director of Public Health shall not charge or collect a fee for health care services provided for the treatment of syphilis, gonorrhea or chancroid.

F. Fees Chargeable to Third-Party Payor: Whenever a chargeable personal health care service or treatment is provided to a recipient for whom third-party financial assistance is available, including but not limited to that from private insurance carriers, ((and)), Medicald Managed Care Plans, Medicare, and Medicaid, the Department shall charge the third-party payor the Fee Category E fee, except for patients covered by Title XIX of the Social Security Act, as amended, the fees for whom shall be those specified in SMC 10.03.130A.

((G. The Director of Public Health is authorized to waive the fees established by this section, for care provided to any recipient who demonstrates, or on whose behalf a demonstration is given, to the reasonable satisfaction of the Director, that such recipient is unable to pay such fees, or when the Director determines that such services are necessary to avert or control a current public health problem.))

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and aproval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter.

Request for legislative action - Personal Health Services Fees

Please find attached SOP 100-014 Request for legislation action and proposed ordinance to update Personal health services fees based on the latest publications by State and Federal guidelines as filed with the City Clerk; to delete special fees as stated on Section B; to waive fees on treatment of chlamydia due to federal funds subsidy the Department receives and to revise Section c, sliding fee scale for pharmaceutical supplies, except as mandated Title X Federal Guidelines for sliding fee scales for Family Planning clinics; except family planning visit fee will be based on the maximum Title XIX allowable charges for E/M code 99204 or 99215.

The proposed fee changes are based on the following:

- 1. Schedule of Maximum Allowances and Program Descriptions May 1992
- 2. HIV Intervention program Operations and Billing manual June 1992
- 3. CSA Poverty Guidelines February 1993
- 4. Procedures under Special Fees have now been deleted and will now adopt the Schedule of Maximum Allowances and Program Descriptions with the latest publication of May 1992, except annual family planning visit fee will be based on the maximum Title XIX allowable charges for E/M code 99204 or 99215.
- 5. Treatment of chlamydia at the Harborview and Broadway STD clinics shall be waived as long as the Department receives federal funding to subsidize these costs per Consolidated Contracts for STD Federal funding support for treatment of chlamydia.
- 6. Revised sliding fee scale to reduced fees for pharmaceutical supplies from no charge to \$5.00.

A proposal to adopt the same fee changes throughout King County will be proposed to the King County Board of Health.

  - 4. Procedures under Special Fees have now been deleted and will now adopt the Schedule of Maximum Allowances and Program Descriptions with the latest publication of May 1992, except the family planning annual visit will be based on the maximum Title XIX allowable charges for E/M code 99204 or 99215
  - 5. Revised sliding fee scale to reduce Pharmacy fees from no charge to slide to \$5.00, except family planning supplies, per Federal mandate
- 3. Revenues are deposited in the Public Health Pooling Fund.
- 4. Revenues support the cost of providing personal health services.
- 5. No new positions are associated with this request.
- 6. No new facilities are associated with this request.
- 7. The program is monitored through the Public Health Information System (PHIS) and the King County's Fiscal Monitoring System (ARMS).
- 8. This request provides enhanced revenues in lieu of local tax support.
