AN ORDINANCE relating to City streets changing the name of a portion of Union Bay Place Northeast Between Northeast 41st Street and Northeast 45th Street to Mary Gates Memorial Drive Northeast on the petition of property owners (C. F. 300332) and superseding Ordinance 102981 to the extent inconsistent.

WHEREAS a petition of abutting property owners requesting the renaming of portion of Northeast 41st Street and Union Bay Place Northeast to Mary Gates Memorial Drive was filed on November 30, 1994;


WHEREAS following a public hearing on said petition on March 7, 1995, the Transportation and Economic Committee of the City Council recommended approval of the petition pursuant to existing street standards;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The name of a portion of Union Bay Place Northeast Between Northeast 41st Street and Northeast 45th Street is hereby changed to Mary Gates Memorial Drive Northeast.

Ordinance 102981 establishing street names within the City is superseded to the extent inconsistent herewith.

Larry Knutson of this office previously sent the blue folder and earlier legislation renaming a portion of Union Bay Place Northeast and Northeast 41st Street "Mary Gates Memorial Drive Northeast" and "Northeast Mary Gates Memorial Drive".

At the Friday, February 17, 1995 meeting of the Street Use Appeals Board, it was decided between petitioners and Board members that renaming only that portion of Union Bay Place Northeast between Northeast 41st Street and Northeast 45th Street was prudent, given the complexities of street name changes.

Councilmember Susan Donaldson, petitioner for the renaming, has the original legislative folder bearing the old title and containing the out-dated draft ordinance. Please replace that ordinance draft and the ordinance title with the attached proposed legislation.
