



ORDINANCE 119994

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AN ORDINANCE relating to the Police Department; authorizing the execution of a grant agreement with the Washington State Traffic Safety Commission through the Washington Association of Sheriffs and Police Chiefs for financial assistance to purchase two laptop computers to enable officers to expedite paperwork and return to the field and to enhance reports that aid in successful prosecution; increasing expenditure allowances in the 1996 Budget of the Police Department; and making an appropriation therefor, all by a three-fourths vote of the City Council.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. As requested by the Chief of Police, the Chief of Police or his designee is authorized to execute an agreement with the Washington State Traffic Safety Commission through the Washington Association of Sheriffs and Police Chiefs for financial assistance in the amount of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) to purchase two laptop computers for use by officers to expedite paperwork and enhance reports that aid in successful prosecution. The funds, when received, are hereby accepted and shall be deposited to the credit of the Supplemental Appropriations Subfund of the Emergency Fund to reimburse for appropriations made in Section 2.

Section 2. To carry out the purposes of the grant agreement, and contingent upon execution of the agreement authorized in Section 1, the following expenditure allowance in the 1996 Budget of the Police Department is increased as follows:

<u>Program Category</u>	<u>Object of Expenditure</u>	<u>Amount</u>
P40	CO - Capital Outlay	\$3,000

and the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000) shall be appropriated from the Supplemental Appropriations Subfund of the Emergency Fund for the purposes outlined in Section 1.

Section 3. Any act consistent with the authority but prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. The foregoing appropriation is made to reimburse actual necessary expenditures of the City for which insufficient appropriation has been made due to causes which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of the adoption of the 1996

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1 Budget; Now, Therefore, in accordance with RCW35.32A, by reason of the facts above  
2 stated, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its  
3 approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10)  
4 days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section  
5 1.04.020.

Dear Councilmember Pageler:

Approval of the City Council is requested for the attached ordinance. This ordinance authorizes the Chief of Police to execute an agreement with the Washington State Traffic Safety Commission through the Washington Association of Sheriffs and Police Chiefs in the amount of \$3,000 to purchase two laptop computers.

The computers will be used by two of the six officers assigned to the DUI Squad. The other four DUI officers were provided laptop computers in 1994 from a similar grant with the Washington Traffic Safety Commission. The six-officer squad is responsible for the interdiction of over 1,500 impaired drivers annually. Because the primary function of this squad is to detect, stop and arrest as many impaired drivers as possible, being able to complete the necessary paperwork and return to the field in a timely manner is a key issue. In addition, the reports of the officers already using laptop computers allow more space for additional information and detailed observations by the officer, both of which aid in successful prosecution.

The total estimated cost of two laptop computers is \$3,300. Funding from this grant will provide nearly 80 percent or \$3,000 of the purchase cost. The remaining \$800 is included in the 1996 Police Department Budget.
