ORDINANCE NO. 118020

AN ORDINANCE appropriating money to pay certain audited claims and ordering the payment thereof.

Be it ordained by the City of Seattle as follows:

SECTION 1. Payment of the sum of Six Million Nine Hundred Ninety Three Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Six and 01\100 (\$6,993,656.01) dollars on SFMS Warrant Issue mechanical warrants numbered 40659493- 40662017 plus manual or cancellation issues for claims against the City which were audited by the Auditing Committee and reported by said committee to the City Council on February 15, 1996 consistent with appropriations heretofore made for such purpose from the appropriate Funds, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. Payment of the sum of Fourteen Million Six Hundred Ninety Six Thousand Three Hundred Seventy Seven and 58\100 (\$14,696,377.58) dollars on City General Salary Fund mechanical warrants numbered 50011717- 50014944 plus manual and agency issues representing Gross Payroll for payroll ending date February 6, 1996 as detailed in the Payroll Summary Report for claims against the City which were audited by the Auditing Committee and reported by said committee to the City Council on Feb. 15, 1996 consistent with appropriations heretofore made for such purpose from the appropriate Funds, is hereby approved.

SECTION 3. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance, being an ordinance required for the payment of salaries or current expenses, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter.




