

ORDINANCE 118023

AN ORDINANCE authorizing an expenditure from the Judgment/Claims Fund to be reimbursed by the Seattle Water Fund to settle the claim of Kenneth Emerick (C-57636), all by a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Upon presentation of a proper release, the City Finance Director is authorized to draw and pay a warrant in the amount of Twenty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$20,000.00). This sum constitutes settlement and full satisfaction of the claim of Kenneth Emerick for injuries sustained on 9-11-94 at or near 12030 - 36th N.E. in Seattle as specified in Clerk's File C-57636. The sum shall be paid from the Judgment/Claims Fund from sums heretofore appropriated for such purposes. The Judgment/Claims Fund shall be reimbursed by the Seattle Water Fund.

Section 2: Pursuant to RCW 35.32A.060(3), this Ordinance, being an Ordinance required to allow a claim or appropriated money or other property to pay or satisfy the same, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval, if approved by the Mayor; but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.



AN ORDINANCE authorizing an expenditure from the Judgment/Claims Fund to be reimbursed by the Seattle Water Fund to settle the claim of Kenneth Emerick (C-57636), all by a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

ORDINANCE NO. 118024

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Department of Housing and Human Services, authorizing an agreement with the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services for financial assistance for the operation of the "Healthy Smiles" Program to enhance dental health services for children of low income families, creating a position, increasing the expenditure allowances in the 1996 budget of the Department of Housing and Human Services, and ratifying and confirming prior acts, all by a three-fourths vote of the City Council.

ORDINANCE NO. 118025

AN ORDINANCE accepting the proposal of Stone Hill Development Corporation to purchase and develop Parcel 11B in the I-90 Redevelopment Project area; authorizing a Contract for Sale of Land and deed; appropriating funds for payment to the State of Washington of the purchase price owing and designating the disposition of sales proceeds; amending Exhibits A-1 and B of Ordinance 118915; and ratifying and confirming prior acts, all by a three-fourths vote of the City Council.

ORDINANCE NO. 118026

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Department of Housing and Human Services, authorizing an agreement with the City of Bellevue for financial assistance for the provision of employment services to seniors, creating a position, increasing the expenditure allowance in the 1996 budget of the Department of Housing and Human Services, and ratifying and confirming prior acts, all by a three-fourths vote of the City Council.

ORDINANCE NO. 118027

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Seattle Public Library, authorizing the execution of two contract agreements with the Washington State Library and one contract agreement with the State of Washington, Department of Community, Trade and Economic Development to provide Library service for the blind, visually impaired, physically handicapped and learning disabled residents of the State of Washington, to manage the development and maintenance of a World Wide Web site on the Internet for Washington state public libraries, and to continue operation of the Pacific Rim Business Information Service and provide information on Asia-Pacific region markets for Washington businesses; and making a reimbursable appropriation from the Library Fund in connection therewith.

ORDINANCE NO. 118028

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Department of Housing and Human Services, authorizing an agreement with the United States Department of Justice for financial assistance for the operation of the "Safe Futures" Program to prevent and reduce youth violence and criminal activity, creating certain positions, increasing the expenditure allowances in the 1996 budget of the Department of Housing and Human Services, and ratifying and confirming prior acts, all by a three-fourths vote of the City Council.

ORDINANCE NO. 118029

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Seattle Department of Parks and Recreation, accepting a \$234,944 grant from the State of Washington Employment Security's Washington Service Corps (WSC), authorizing execution of a subsequent service agreement with WSC for financial assistance to support and develop a Youth Apprenticeship program at Seattle Housing Authority's Holly Park Garden Residence; increasing the expenditure allowances in the Department's 1996 Budget; and making a reimbursable appropriation from the Park Fund, all by a three-fourths vote of the City Council.

ORDINANCE NO. 118030

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Department of Neighborhoods; authorizing execution of a grant agreement between King County Parks, Cultural and Natural Resources Department and the City of Seattle Department of Neighborhoods to accept \$10,000 from the Youth Sports Facility Grant Fund on behalf of Greenwood, NW to be added to the existing Neighborhoods Matching Fund award for the Webster Playground Project in Ballard, all by a three-fourths vote of the City Council.
