ORDINANCE 11802-1

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Department of Housing and Human Services, authorizing an agreement with the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services for financial assistance for the operation of the "Healthy Smiles" Program to enhance dental health services for children of low income families, creating a position, increasing the expenditure allowances in the 1996 budget of the Department of Housing and Human Services, and ratifying and confirming prior acts, all by a three-fourths vote of the City Council.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. As requested by the Director of the Department of Housing and Human Services and recommended by the Mayor, the Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for financial assistance from the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services for the operation of the "Healthy Smiles" Program in the amount of Two Hundred Twenty-Eight Thousand Three Hundred and Seventy-Seven Dollars (\$228,377), and, upon acceptance of such application, the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute and deliver for and on behalf of The City of Seattle an agreement in such counterparts as may be necessary to accept the financial assistance. Funds, when received, shall be deposited into the Housing and Human Services Operating Fund. The Mayor or his designee is further authorized to execute and deliver such other documents relating to the agreement as may be required in connection therewith. The agreement and such other documents shall be in form and content consistent with the City Charter and other applicable law.

Section 2. Contingent upon the execution of the agreement authorized in Section 1 hereof, the expenditure allowances for the following objects of expenditures in the 1996 budget of the Department of Housing and Human Services, Program and Program Category Family and Youth Services (Code H1200), are hereby increased as follows:

OC	Other Charges	95,859





Section 5. The foregoing appropriations are made to meet actual necessary expenditures for the City for which insufficient appropriations have been made due to causes which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of the adoption of the 1996 budget; Now, therefore, in accordance with RCA 35.32A.060, by reason of the facts above stated, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.



SUBJECT: Legislation Authorizing Additional Authority, Appropriations
and Position for New *Healthy Smiles* Program

I am pleased to forward the attached proposed legislation which would provide the budget authority, appropriations and a position for the administration of an exciting new program to improve the dental health of approximately 3,500 Medicaid-eligible young children in Seattle. The *Healthy Smiles* program is a new initiative of the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services. Through a competitive proposal process, the Department has been awarded \$228,377 in a 17-month grant with client services expected to start in mid-March.

The project was developed in cooperation with the Seattle Public Schools Health Services and Head Start Program, the Washington Foundation's Community Health Access Program, Neighborhood House, the Denise Louis Early Childhood Development Center and the Department's Comprehensive Child Care, Child Nutrition and Head Start programs. Program services will build on established networks of community-based services, with approximately 1,000 children to be served through child care centers, 1,000 through Family Centers, Teen Parent programs and other community sites and over 1,500 through Head Start Program sites. The project will address the high incidence of serious dental disease which has been found to affect low income children, children of color and children with non-English speaking backgrounds at disproportionate rates. A recent evaluation found that over one-quarter of children enrolled in the Head Start Program had untreated dental disease, and at program sites serving predominantly Southeast Asian children, the rate rose to almost 45 percent.

The program will integrate dental health education and support in accessing dental care services into other health education and supportive case management systems that already exist in local community programs. The grant funds will support additional staff and services in programs serving low-income children. A full-time dental hygienist will be hired by the Seattle Public Schools Head Start Program.

The hygienist will work in concert with present Seattle Public Schools Health Care Services staff serving Head Start Program children. An additional half-time dental case manager will be hired in both the Neighborhood House and Denise Louie Head Start Programs. These positions will provide dental screening, connect parents with dentists and transportation assistance to assure needed dental services are provided, provide parent education and follow-up and work to incorporate good oral health practices into each child's regular activities. One new Senior Grants and Contracts Specialist position is requested for the Division of Family and Youth Services to serve as the project coordinator and identify and support implementation of changes to the system of dental services to low income children.

The attached legislation authorizes the receipt of the full \$228,377 grant, appropriates \$149,885 of the funds expected to be spent in 1996 and creates the new grant-funded Senior Grants and Contracts Specialist position. Indirect costs in the amount of \$16,039 are not appropriated. The balance of the grant funding will be included in the Department's 1997-98 Budget. The requested position is being coordinated with the City Personnel Department.
