4 AN ORDINANCE relating to the Seattle Public Library; authorizing the execution of two contract  
5 agreements with the Washington State Library and one contract agreement with the State of  
6 Washington Department of Community, Trade and Economic Development to provide Library  
7 service for the blind, visually impaired, physically handicapped and learning disabled  
8 residents of the State of Washington, to manage the development and maintenance of a World  
9 Wide Web site on the Internet for Washington state public libraries, and to continue operation  
10 of the Pacific Rim Business Information Service and provide information on Asia/Pacific  
11 region markets for Washington businesses; and making a reimbursable appropriation from the  
12 Library Fund in connection therewith.

9 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:**

10 Section 1. As requested by the City Librarian and recommended by the Mayor, the Seattle  
11 Public Library is hereby authorized to execute two (2) contract agreements with the Washington State  
12 Library in the total amount of Two Million Six Hundred Thirty-three Thousand Sixteen Dollars  
13 (\$2,633,016) to provide services for the blind, visually impaired, physically handicapped and learning  
14 disabled residents of the State of Washington by the Washington Talking Book and Braille Library,  
15 and to administer a project to establish and maintain a World Wide Web site on the Internet with an  
16 emphasis on information specific to Washington for Washington citizens maintained by public  
17 librarians. The Seattle Public Library is also authorized to execute one (1) contract agreement with the  
18 State of Washington Department of Community, Trade and Economic Development in the amount of  
19 Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) to continue providing information on Asia/Pacific region  
20 markets for small- to medium-sized Washington businesses.

21 Section 2. Contingent upon the execution of all three agreements authorized in Section 1, the  
22 expenditure allowance in the 1995 budget of the Library department, Intellectual Environment subfund  
23 (10446) is increased by the sum of Two Million Six Hundred Fifty-eight Thousand Sixteen Dollars  
24 (\$2,658,016); and for such purposes as shown below, a like sum is hereby appropriated from the  
25 Library Fund. The Library Fund shall be reimbursed from funds received, as shown below, from the  
26 Washington State Library in the amount of Two Million Six Hundred Thirty-three Thousand Sixteen  
27 Dollars (\$2,633,016) and the Washington State Department Community, Trade and Economic  
28 Development in the amount of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) and deposited in the Library  
29 Fund. Expenditures shall be paid upon vouchers approved by the City Librarian.


9 All funds that are unexpended at the end of a budget year are automatically carried over to the  
10 following year.

11 Section 3. The foregoing appropriations are made to meet actual necessary expenditures of  
12 the City for which insufficient appropriation has been made due to causes which could not reasonably  
13 have been foreseen at the time of the adoption of the 1995 Budget, in accordance with RCW  
14 35.32A.060.


15 Section 4. Any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this  
16 ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

17 Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its  
18 approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after  
19 presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.



The Seattle Public Library is requesting appropriation of \$2,658,016 from the Library Fund, to be reimbursed by grant funds received in the same amount. Three projects have been submitted together in a single ordinance as follows:

Org B4198/B4199 - Washington State Library/Library Services & Construction Act -  
Washington Talking Book & Braille Library - 1995-1997 Biennium Contract

The Washington State Library will reimburse the Seattle Public Library \$2,385,516 (B4198) in State of Washington funds and \$108,000 (B4199) in Library Services & Construction Act funds. The Seattle Public Library has administered the Washington Talking Book and Braille Library (WTBBL) since 1931, providing library services to eligible blind, visually impaired, physically handicapped, and learning disabled residents of the State of Washington. The current contract runs from October 1, 1995 through June 30, 1997.

Org B4201 - Washington State Department of Trade and Community Development - Pacific Rim  
Business Information Services (PRBIS)

Since 1987, the Seattle Public Library has received funding from the Washington State Library to provide information on markets in the Asia/Pacific region trade to small- to medium-sized Washington businesses in cooperation with other Washington state libraries. The Seattle Public Library has received a \$25,000 contract to continue the primary functions of the PRBIS and explore alternate funding options to continue the service. The contract period is from October 2, 1995 through January 15, 1996.

Org B4202 - Washington State Library - Washington State Public Libraries World Wide Web  
Site

The Washington State Library has proposed a contract with the Seattle Public Library for \$139,500 to have the Seattle Public Library manage a project to develop and maintain a World Wide Web (WWW) site for public libraries throughout the state. The WWW site will be constructed and maintained by public librarians and will emphasize information specific to Washington. The term of this contract is from December 1, 1995 through September 30, 1996.
