1 AN ORDINANCE appropriating money to pay certain audited claims and ordering  
the payment thereof.

2 Be it ordained by the City of Seattle as follows:

3 SECTION 1. Payment of the sum of Twelve Million Four Hundred Eighty Eight  
4 Thousand Two Hundred Eighty One and 79/100 ( 12,488,281.79 ) Dollars on SFMS  
5 Warrant Issue mechanical warrants numbered 40664759-40667070 plus manual or  
6 cancellation issues for claims against the City which were audited by the Auditing  
7 Committee and reported by said committee to the City Council on February 29, 1996  
8 consistent with appropriations heretofore made for such purpose from the appropriate  
9 Funds, is hereby approved.

10 SECTION 2. Payment of the sum of Fourteen Million Seven Hundred Fifty Seven  
11 Thousand One Hundred Ninety Five and 96/100 (14,757,195.96) Dollars on City  
12 General Salary Fund mechanical warrants numbered 50015572 - 50018742 plus  
13 manual and agency issues representing Gross Payroll for payroll ending date February  
14 20, 1996 as detailed in the Payroll Summary Report for claims against the City which  
15 were audited by the Auditing Committee and reported by said committee to the City  
16 Council on February 29, 1996 consistent with appropriations heretofore made for  
17 such purpose from the appropriate Funds, is hereby approved.

18 SECTION 3. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective  
19 date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

20 SECTION 4. This ordinance, being an ordinance required for the payment of salaries  
21 or current expenses, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval, if  
22 approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force immediately  
23 upon its approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time  
24 it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter.

ORDINANCE NO. 118033

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Department of Parks and Recreation, authorizing a grant agreement with the State of Washington's Park and Recreation Commission for financial assistance to implement a boating safety awareness program on Green Lake and Lake Washington, increasing the expenditure allowance in the Department's 1996 budget, and making a reimbursable appropriation from the Park Fund, all by a three-fourths vote of the City Council.
