


1 AN ORDINANCE relating to telecommunications; authorizing the Department of
2 Administrative Services to amend an inter-agency agreement with King County to
3 extend the fiber optic cable installed pursuant to Ordinance 117745.
4
5 WHEREAS, the City of Seattle and King County entered into an agreement for the installation
6 of a shared fiber optic cable pursuant to Ordinance 117745; and
7
8 WHEREAS, King County has requested a modification to the scope of the project to extend
9 the fiber optic cable to the Smith Tower; and
10
11 WHEREAS, the City of Seattle Department of Administrative Services believes that
12 participating in the extension of the fiber optic cable is in the best interest of the City of
13 Seattle; and
14
15 WHEREAS, the extension of the fiber optic cable requires the use of underground conduit in
16 Third Avenue owned by the Department of Administrative Services; and
17
18 WHEREAS, the extension of the fiber optic cable also requires the use of underground conduit
19 owned by the Seattle Engineering Department; and
20
21 WHEREAS, the Seattle Engineering Department has concurred with the use of its conduit with
22 conditions; and, NOW, THEREFORE,
23
24 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:
25
26 Section 1. The Director of the Department of Administrative Services is authorized to
27 execute an amendment ("Amendment") to the Project Agreement between King County and
28 the City of Seattle, Department of Administrative Services dated August 10, 1995 ("Project
Agreement") to provide for the extension of the fiber optic cable to the Smith Tower, provided
that the Amendment includes the conditions specified by the Seattle Engineering Department
for the use of its conduit. This Ordinance specifically authorizes the use of City-owned
conduit, respectively managed by the Department of Administrative Services and the Seattle
Engineering Department for such extension.
Section 2. The terms and conditions of the Project Agreement, except as required to
effectuate the extension of the fiber optic cable, and as required to meet the conditions of the
Seattle Engineering Department as discussed in Section 1, shall remain consistent with the
Project Agreement.

1 Section 3. The cost sharing for the extension shall be consistent with the principles
2 and methods used in the Project Agreement.

3 Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and
4 after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10)
5 days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.




