ORDINANCE NO. 118056

AN ORDINANCE appropriating money to pay certain audited claims and ordering the payment thereof.

Be it ordained by the City of Seattle as follows:

SECTION 1. Payment of the sum of Fourteen Million Five Hundred Nine Thousand Six Hundred Thirteen and 49100 (\$14,509,613.49) dollars on SFMS Warrant Issue mechanical warrants numbered 40669561 - 40672591 plus manual or cancellation issues for claims against the City which were audited by the Auditing Committee and reported by said committee to the City Council on March 14, 1996 consistent with appropriations heretofore made for such purpose from the appropriate Funds, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2 . Payment of the sum of Fourteen Million Five Hundred Ninety Five Thousand One Hundred Seventy One and 72100 (\$14,595,171.72) dollars on City Light Salary Fund mechanical warrants numbered 50019364 - 50022587 plus manual and agency issues representing Gross Payroll for payroll ending date March 5, 1996 as detailed in the Payroll Summary Report for claims against the City which were audited by the Auditing Committee and reported by said committee to the City Council on March 14, 1996 consistent with appropriations heretofore made for such purpose from the appropriate Funds, is hereby approved.

SECTION 3. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance, being an ordinance required for the payment of salaries or current expenses, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter.
