3 AN ORDINANCE related to the Neighborhood Planning Office; authorizing the Director to  
4 accept funds from the Port of Seattle; and appropriating funds for neighborhood planning  
5 efforts for the North Duwamish Industrial Planning Area and the Ballard Interbay  
6 Northend Manufacturing and Industrial Center; all by a 3/4 vote of the City Council.

7 WHEREAS, The Port of Seattle wishes to contribute \$10,000 to the Neighborhood Planning  
8 Office for the specific purpose of studying transportation issues in the sub-planning area  
9 called the North Duwamish Industrial Planning; and

10 WHEREAS, the City of Seattle previously accepted \$12,000 from the Port of Seattle through its  
11 interlocal agreement dated January 17, 1997, authorized by Ordinance 118508, and these  
12 funds should be appropriated for the specific purposes as set forth in the Interlocal  
13 Agreement; Now, Therefore,

14 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

15 Section 1. The Director of the Neighborhood Planning Office is authorized to accep  
16 contribution from the Port of Seattle in the amount of \$10,000 which shall be deposited into the  
17 General Fund.

18 Section 2. Upon receipt of the funds identified in Section 1, the expenditure allowance in  
19 the 1997 Budget of the Neighborhood Planning Office is hereby increased by the sum of Ten  
20 Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), as follows:

<u>Program Category</u>	<u>Object of Expenditure</u>	<u>Amount</u>
X7N - NPO	OC - Other Charges	\$10,000

21 Said increase shall be supported by the appropriation, hereby made and authorized, of a like  
22 amount from the General Fund. Said funds shall be used to fund an analysis of local access and  
23 circulation issues for Port of Seattle terminals and businesses in the North Duwamish planning  
24 area.

1 Section 3. The \$12,000 provided from the Port pursuant to Ordinance 118508 shall be  
2 deposited in the General Fund.

3 Section 4. Upon deposit to the General Fund of the funds identified in Section 3, the  
4 expenditure allowance in the 1997 Budget of the Neighborhood Planning Office is hereby  
5 increased by the sum of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000), as follows:

<u>Program Category</u>	<u>Object of Expenditure</u>	<u>Amount</u>
X7N - NPO	OC - Other Charges	\$12,000

8 Said increase shall be supported by the appropriation, hereby made and authorized, of a like  
9 amount from the General Fund. Said funds shall be used to study the fishing and maritime  
10 industries in the Ballard Interbay Northend Manufacturing and Industrial Center.

11 Section 5. Any acts done consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of  
12 this ordinance, are hereby ratified and confirmed.

13 Section 6. Any appropriation unexpended in 1997 and still available shall be carried over  
14 into the 1998 budget of the Neighborhood Planning Office.

15 Section 7. The foregoing appropriations are made to meet actual necessary expenditures  
16 of the City for which no appropriations have been made due to causes which could not  
17 reasonably have been foreseen at the time of the adoption of the 1997 Budget; Now, Therefore,  
18 in accordance with RCW 35.32A.060, by reason of the facts above stated this ordinance shall  
19 take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by





**SUBJECT:** Legislation Request for Accepting Port of Seattle Funds

Honorable Council President:

The Neighborhood Planning Office hereby requests enactment of legislation authorizing NPO to accept funds from the Port of Seattle, totaling \$22,000, to be used for neighborhood planning efforts in the North Duwamish Industrial Planning Area and the Ballard Interbay Northend Manufacturing and Industrial Center (BINMIC).

Funds in the amount of \$12,000 for the BINMIC have previously been accepted by the interlocal agreement dated January 17, 1997 (Ordinance 118508). However, the authorizing legislation neglected to indicate specifics about making the funds available through the Neighborhood Planning Office. The attached legislation shows this and allows an increase in the expenditure allowance of NPO's 1997 Budget of \$12,000.

Acceptance of a \$10,000 contribution from the Port would be used to fund an analysis of local access and circulation issues for Port of Seattle terminals and businesses in the North Duwamish planning area. 
