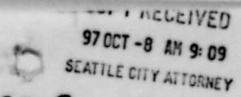

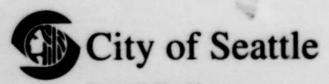

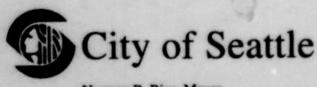
Dear Council President Drago:

The Department of Parks and Recreation is herein proposing legislation to accept statutory warranty deeds and a conservation easement for certain properties purchased for open space, park, and recreation purposes through the Open Space Program. The properties were purchased with funds from the Open Space and Trails Bond Fund, Regional Conservation Futures Bond Program, and King County Conservation Futures Tax. The funding for some of the purchased properties is partially reimbursable from grants through the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation (IAC) under the Washington Wildlife and Recreation Program (WWRP). The Open Space and Trails Bond Fund, and the authority to purchase the properties, so funded, were created by Ordinance 114900 in accordance with the voters' approval of the King County open space acquisition and trails bond issue in the election of November 7, 1989. The authority to purchase properties funded by the King County Conservation Futures Tax Collections was authorized under Ordinances 115855, 116386, 117162, 117997, and 118252. The authority to purchase properties funded by the Regional Conservation Futures Bond Program was authorized under Ordinances 117070 and 118212.

The deeds referenced in the attached legislation include fifty-three (53) properties in seven designated greenbelts, and one (1) conservation easement in St. Mark's Greenbelt. These acquisitions add 34.97 acres of open space located in greenbelts to the 116.64 acres already accepted under the Open Space Program for a total of 151.61 acres of greenbelt property. The previous deed acceptance ordinances for the Open Space Program included Ordinances: 115856, 116063, 116177, 116788, 116892, 116894, 116961, 117087, 117122, 117224, 117274, 117336, 117343, 117344, 117347, 117377, 117442, 117561, 117634, 117637, 117639, 117719, 117849, 118070, 118073, 118151, 118306, 118335, and 118543.
