6 the system of supervision for municipal courts in cities with a population of over 400,000 so that
7 the Court Administrator now supervises the Director of Probation Services instead of the
8 Presiding Judge, and

9 WHEREAS, The City of Seattle intends to conform to the revised statute; NOW, THEREFORE,

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:


11 Section 1. Section 3.33.180 of the Seattle Municipal Code is amended as follows:

12 **3.33.180 Director of Probation Services-Probation officers- Bailiffs.**


13 The judges of the Municipal Court shall appoint a Director of Probation Services who shall,
14 under the direction and supervision of the Court Administrator ((presiding judge)) of the Municipal
15 Court, supervise the probation officers of the Municipal Court. The judges of the Municipal Court shall
16 also appoint a bailiff for the Court, together with such number of probation officers and additional
17 bailiffs as may be authorized by ordinance. The Director of Probation Services, probation officers, and
18 bailiff or bailiffs shall be paid as provided by ordinance.

19 Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its
20 approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after
21 presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
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


Dear President Donaldson:



AN ORDINANCE amending Section 3.53.180 of the Seattle Municipal Code, to change supervision of the Director of Probation Services from the Presiding Judge to the Court Administrator.

WHEREAS, RCW 35.20.290 was amended by the Legislature in Chapter 238, Laws of 1998, changing the system of supervision for municipal courts in cities with a population of over 400,000 so that the Court Administrator now supervises the Director of Probation Services instead of the Presiding Judge, and

WHEREAS, The City of Seattle intends to conform to the revised statute; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3.53.180 of the Seattle Municipal Code is amended as follows:

3.53.180 DIRECTOR OF PROBATION SERVICES -- PROBATION OFFICERS -- BAILIFFS.

The judges of the Municipal Court shall appoint a Director of Probation Services who shall, under the direction and supervision of the Court Administrator (presiding judge) of the Municipal Court, supervise the probation officers of the Municipal Court. The judges of the Municipal Court shall also appoint a bailiff for the Court, together with such number of probation officers and additional bailiffs as may be authorized by ordinance. The Director of Probation Services, probation officers, and bailiff or bailiffs shall be paid as provided by ordinance.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
