ORDINANCE 119385

AN ORDINANCE relating to the base service charge for water services for certain customers of Seattle Public Utilities with twenty inch water meters; and amending Seattle Municipal Code Section 21.04.440 in connection therewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection B of Seattle Municipal Code Section 21.04.440 is amended as follows:

B. Commercial. The rates for metered water supplied to premises other than single-family, duplex residences, and master-metered residential developments not within the City in one (1) month, or fractional part thereof, shall be based on a commodity charge and a base service charge in accordance with the following schedule:

Legislation Title: An ORDINANCE relating to the base service charge for water services for certain customers of the Seattle Public Utilities with twenty inch water meters; and amending Seattle Municipal Code Section 21.04.440 in connection therewith.

Summary of the Legislation: This ordinance corrects the monthly base service charge for commercial customers outside the City with twenty inch (20") water meters. The ordinance changes the base service charge from \$ 948.00 per month to \$946.00 per month. This change will bring the charge into alignment with other outside City base service charges in the rate ordinance.

Background (Include justification for the legislation and funding history, if applicable): This corrects a typographical error in Ordinance Number 119267, passed November 23, 1998.

Dear Council President Donaldson:

Seattle Public Utilities respectfully requests the City Council's enactment of legislation correcting a typographical error in the 1999 water rates.

The error is in the Base Service Charge for 20" meters for commercial customers outside the City. The amending ordinance would change the monthly charge from \$ 948.00 per month to \$ 946.00 per month. The correct charge (of \$ 946.00 per month) is listed in the current ordinance (No. 119267) for master-metered customers in 1999 and 2000 and for commercial customers in 2000, but is incorrectly stated for commercial customers in 1999. This change affects two meters on our system but the revenue impacts are insignificant.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the base service charge for water services for certain customers of Seattle Public Utilities with twenty inch water meters; and amending Seattle Municipal Code Section 21.04.440 in connection therewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection B of Seattle Municipal Code Section 21.04.440 is amended as follows:

B. Commercial. The rates for metered water supplied to premises other than single-family, duplex residences, and master-metered residential developments not within the City in one (1) month, or fractional part thereof, shall be based on a commodity charge and a base service charge in accordance with the following schedule:

BASE SERVICE CHARGE

METER SIZE -- MONTHLY CHARGE

3/4 inch and less -- \$3.80.

1 inch -- 6.00.

1 1/2 inch -- 11.70.

2 inch -- 18.60.

3 inch -- 36.00.

4 inch -- 57.00.

6 inch -- 114.00.

8 inch -- 182.00.

10 inch -- 274.00.

12 inch -- 388.00.

16 inch -- 650.00.

20 inch -- ~~(948.00)~~ 948.00.

24 inch -- 1,516.00.

Section 2. Any act consistent with authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
