ORDINANCE 120372

AN ORDINANCE amending SMC Chapter 15.64 to prohibit skybridge permits for skybridges that would impair public views on designated Downtown view corridors.

WHEREAS, the Seattle City Council finds that it is not in the public interest to permit the construction of skybridges in Downtown Seattle that would impair public views on designated Downtown view corridors,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 15.64 of the Seattle Municipal Code is amended to add a new section to be numbered, titled, and to read as follows:

**15.64.026 Skybridges prohibited on Downtown view corridors**

No skybridge permit may be approved for any skybridge that is proposed to be built over a street that is designated as a Downtown view corridor on the Downtown View Corridor Map adopted by Resolution 30297, which map is incorporated by reference herein.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.





WHEREAS, the Seattle City Council finds that it is not in the public interest to permit the construction of skybridges in Downtown Seattle that would impair public views on designated Downtown view corridors,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 15.04 of the Seattle Municipal Code is amended to add a new section to be numbered, titled, and to read as follows:

#### 15.54.026 SKYBRIDGE PROHIBITED ON DOWNTOWN VIEW CORRIDORS

No skybridge permit may be approved for any skybridge that is proposed to be built over a street that is designated as a Downtown view corridor on the Downtown View Corridor Map adopted by Resolution 30297, which map is incorporated by reference herein.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.
