ORDINANCE 121066

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Department of Parks and Recreation; amending Section 18.12.080 of the Seattle Municipal Code to modify that portion of Westcrest Park designated as the off-leash area at Westcrest Park.

WHEREAS, in September 1997 the City Council passed Ordinance 118724 which identifies the location and boundaries of the Westcrest Park Off Leash Area; and

WHEREAS, Seattle voters approved Proposition 1 (2000 Parks Levy) in November 2000, which included \$516,000 for improvements to Westcrest Park including the off leash area, trails and other park amenities; and

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2002 the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation determined that no significant environmental impacts were likely to occur as a result of the change in boundaries and related improvements to the Westcrest Park Off Leash Area and on June 13, 2002 issued a Determination of Non-significance (DNS); and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation is in the process of constructing improvements to the off-leash area at Westcrest Park;

NOW, THEREFORE,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:**

5 Section 2. Effective when the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation files with the City  
6 Clerk a declaration that the physical improvements to the off-leash area at Westcrest Park  
7 changes have been substantially completed and that the Superintendent has taken steps necessary  
8 to facilitate transition to the new off-leash area configuration including consultation with the  
9 leadership of the Westcrest Off Leash Group, Subsection B5 of Section 18.12.080 of the Seattle  
10 Municipal Code is amended as follows:






**Westcrest Park




**Westcrest Park


